A new website has been developed for the Ministry of the Environment that can be accessed from the Gibraltar Government website (www.gibraltar.gov.gi).

The site is being launched today and will offer up to date information on the responsibilities and functions of the Ministry and its two departments, the Department of the Environment and Technical Services Department.

In the case of Technical Services, the site is still under construction and will be going live at a later date. However, the Department of the Environment offers extensive information about the Department's role and its diverse responsibilities. As well as easy access to EU and local environmental legislation, it will also be possible to link to other government departments, agencies and local NGO's.

A facility to download forms required to carry out a service at the Cemetery is also available. The site will also offer information on activities such as World Environment Day and other events held throughout the year.

The recently signed Environment Charter by the Hon the Chief Minister and the Minister for the Environment can also be viewed.

Commenting on the new facility the Minister for the Environment, the Hon J J Netto, said "The coming on-line of the Ministry for the Environment website is part of our genuine commitment to transparency and accountability to the public. Users of the site will find useful information on services and legislation in relation to the Ministry, and its two departments. It will also make those providing the service more contactable. The website will continue to grow in order to offer the public new services and information when available."
