MUSEUM LECTURES IN SPANISH UNIVERSITIES

The Gibraltar Museum has been involved in a series of lectures about Gibraltar, given in several Spanish universities. Last week Professor Clive Finlayson was guest speaker at the University of Cádiz where he gave a lecture on “heritage management in Gibraltar”. Just prior to Christmas Professor Finlayson lectured on the palaeoecology of the region of the Strait to undergraduates in the University of Córdoba. This had been preceded by a seminar on the recent Gibraltar Neanderthal discoveries in the University of Huelva in which Professor Finlayson and Drs Darren Fa and Geraldine Finlayson of the museum gave a series of lectures on the subject. In February, lectures will be given at the University of Tarragona in Cataluña.

These invitations serve to highlight the high profile that the research being carried out in Gibraltar is receiving across Spain. The recent late Neanderthal discoveries have received particular prominence and have served as platform to increase awareness of the wider heritage richness of the Rock. All the lectures were very well attended and were received with great interest and discussion by the audience.
