Gibraltar to be represented at the Posidonia Exhibition- the International Shipping Exhibition

The Port of Gibraltar will be participating in this year's Posidonia Exhibition. The exhibition will take place from 2nd-6th June at the Hellenikon Exhibition Centre in Piraeus, Greece and is the biggest global trade show specifically for shipping, attended by over 16,000 visitors. Posidonia is considered the primary event at which the global maritime community gathers.

The Port of Gibraltar will have its own stand- number 242-10 in the Maritime London Pavilion of the trade show.

Albert Poggio, Director of the Government of Gibraltar London Office and MedCruise Senior Vice President, and Alan Cubbin, Maritime Administrator, will head the team manning the Gibraltar stand and will be Gibraltar Port's representation at the show.

The Gibraltar stand is being part-sponsored by Gibraltar based industry players, Aegean Bunkering (Gibraltar) Ltd, Gibunco Group, Cammell Laird (Gibraltar) Ltd and Vemaoil Company Ltd. Other minor sponsors include Slop Oil Reception & Treatment Ltd, Marine Service Shipping (Gibraltar) Ltd and Bunkers (Gibraltar) Ltd.

Minister with responsibility for the Port, the Hon J J Holliday commented:
