### **Grand Ocean Plaza and Majestic Ocean Plaza Developments – Removal of Cranes**

In order to allow works to remove the tower cranes at the Grand Ocean Plaza and Majestic Ocean Plaza developments, the following traffic diversions will be put in place.

Waterport Road from its junction with Waterport Roundabout to the entrance to Ocean Village will be closed off to traffic whilst the mobile crane that is to be used for the works is being assembled. This will take place from 2.00 a.m. to no later than 7.00 a.m. on the morning of Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2009.

During this time the section of Queensway from its junction with Devil's Tongue Road to Waterport Roundabout and Waterport Road from its junction with Waterport Roundabout to its junction Devil's Tongue Road will be closed off to vehicular traffic.

Traffic travelling in a northbound direction along Queensway will be diverted into Reclamation Road at its junction with Queensway adjacent to King's Bastion and will continue along Chatham Counterguard road and Fish Market Road to Waterport Roundabout.

Access to St Bernard's Hospital and the Housing Estates in the reclamation area will be via Europort Avenue.

Once the mobile crane has been erected works to dismantle the tower crane will continue as from 2.00pm on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> and throughout Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2009. There will be no traffic implications during this time.

Access for pedestrians will be directed by site operatives as required.

Appropriate signage for the guidance of drivers and pedestrians will be displayed in the vicinity of the works.
