GENERAL NOTES

Applicants for a learner’s licence in any of the categories C to J will be required to produce a medical certificate (Form 19) duly completed by a medical practitioner registered in Gibraltar, stating that the applicant has not later than six months before the date of application, been examined and found medically fit to drive.

There shall be clearly displayed in a conspicuous manner on the front and on the back of the vehicle driven by a learner, a distinguishing mark, consisting of the letter “L” in red colour on a white background, which shall conform with Regulation 85 (3) of the Traffic (Licensing & Registrations) Regulations. They should be removed when the vehicle is not been driven by a learner.

ELIGIBILITY

In addition to the qualifying residence period of 185 days, applicants must also possess legal residence in Gibraltar, i.e. Permit of Residence or I.D. Card.

LICENCE CATEGORIES

EC CATEGORIES

- B** Motor - vehicles with up to 8 passenger seats and up to 3500Kg with a trailer up to 750Kg.
- C1** Motor - vehicles over 3500Kg but not more than 7500Kg.
- C** Motor - vehicles over 3500Kg with a trailer up to 750Kg.
- D1** Passenger - carrying vehicles with 9 to 16 passenger seats with a trailer up to 750Kg.
- D** Passenger - carrying vehicles with more than 8 passenger seats with a trailer up to 750Kg.
- B+E** Motor - vehicles with up to 8 passenger seats and up to 3500Kg with a trailer over 750Kg.
- C1+E** Motor - vehicles between 3500Kg and 7500Kg with a trailer over 750Kg total weight not more than 12000Kg.
- C+E** Articulated - vehicles or large vehicles over 3500Kg with a trailer over 750Kg.
- D1+E** Passenger - carrying vehicles with 9 to 16 passenger seats with a trailer over 750Kg. Total weight not more than 12000Kg.
- D+E** Passenger - carrying vehicles in category D with a trailer over 750Kg.

NATIONAL CATEGORIES

- F** Motor Vehicles designed, constructed and used for the purpose of trench digging or any kind of excavating or shovelling work.
- G** Motor Vehicles designed and constructed as mobile cranes.
- H** Road Rollers.
- I** Motor Vehicles of any description not included in categories A to D and F to I.
- J** Motor Vehicles of categories F to J towing a trailer with a laden weight exceeding 750Kg.
