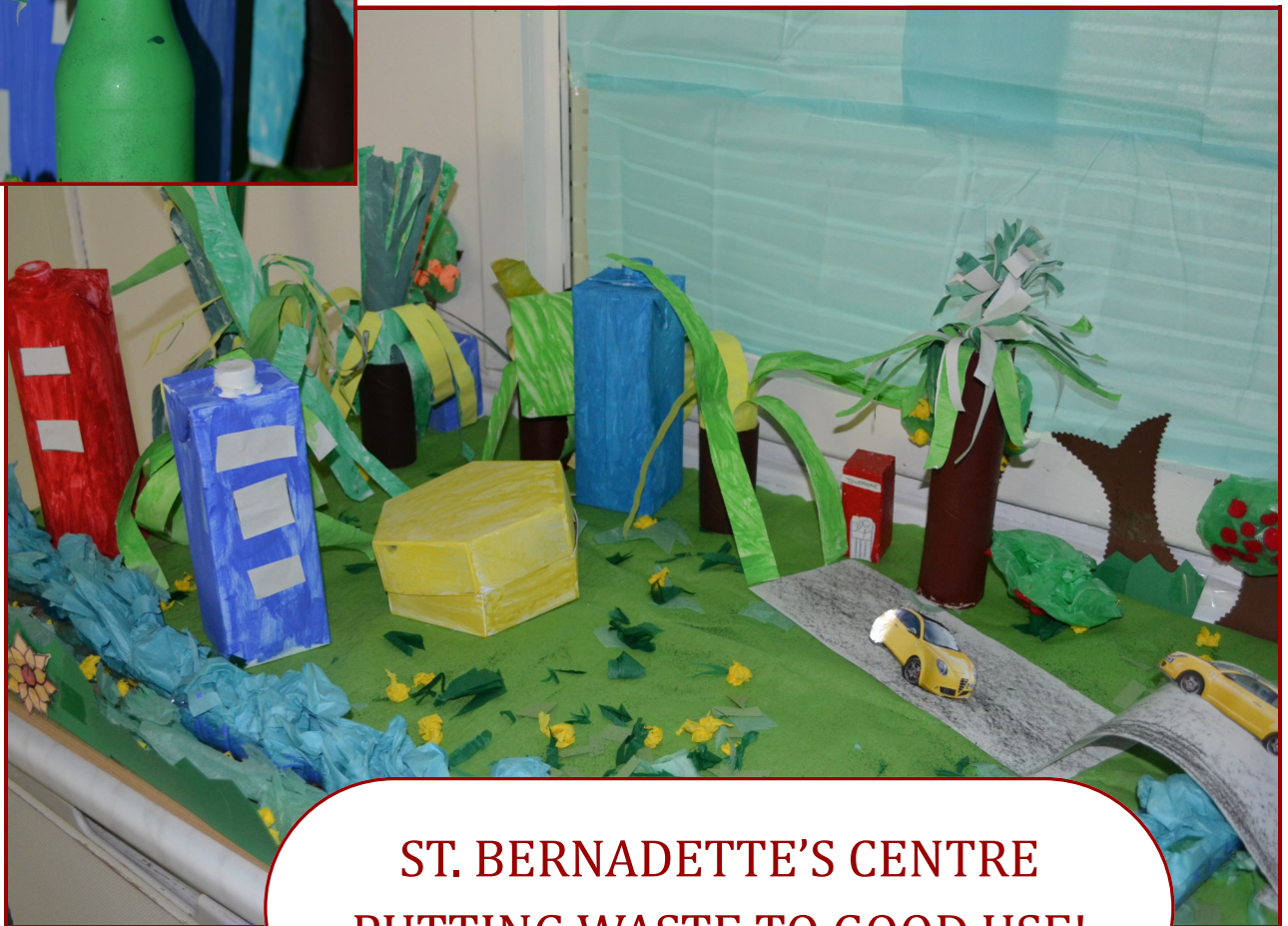




# FOOD WASTE
