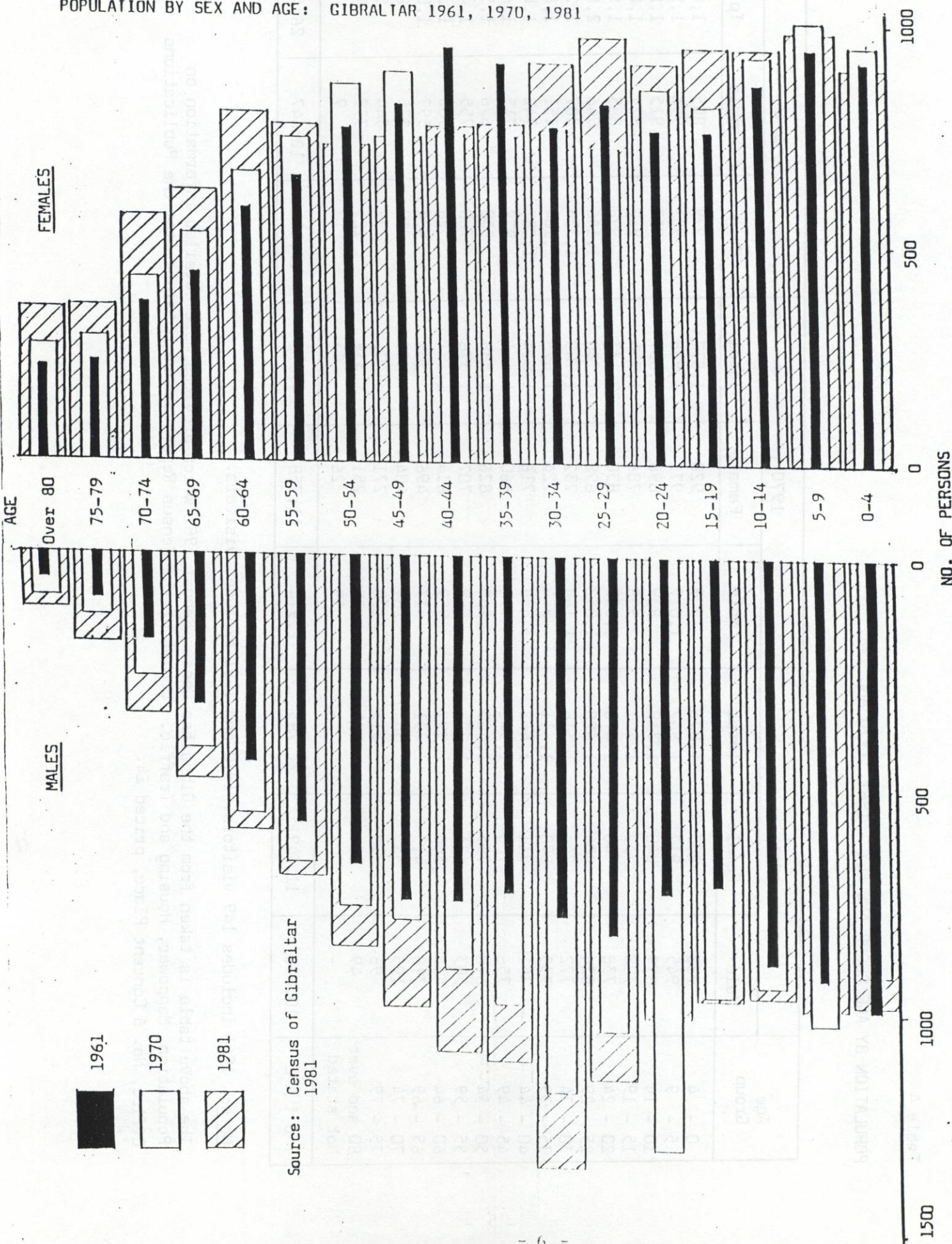

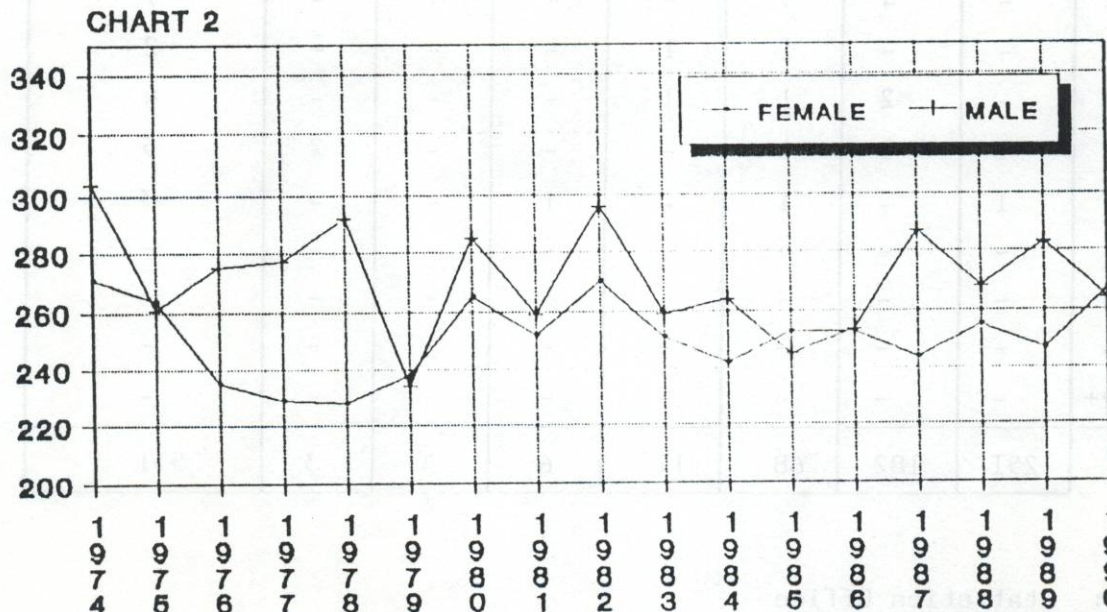

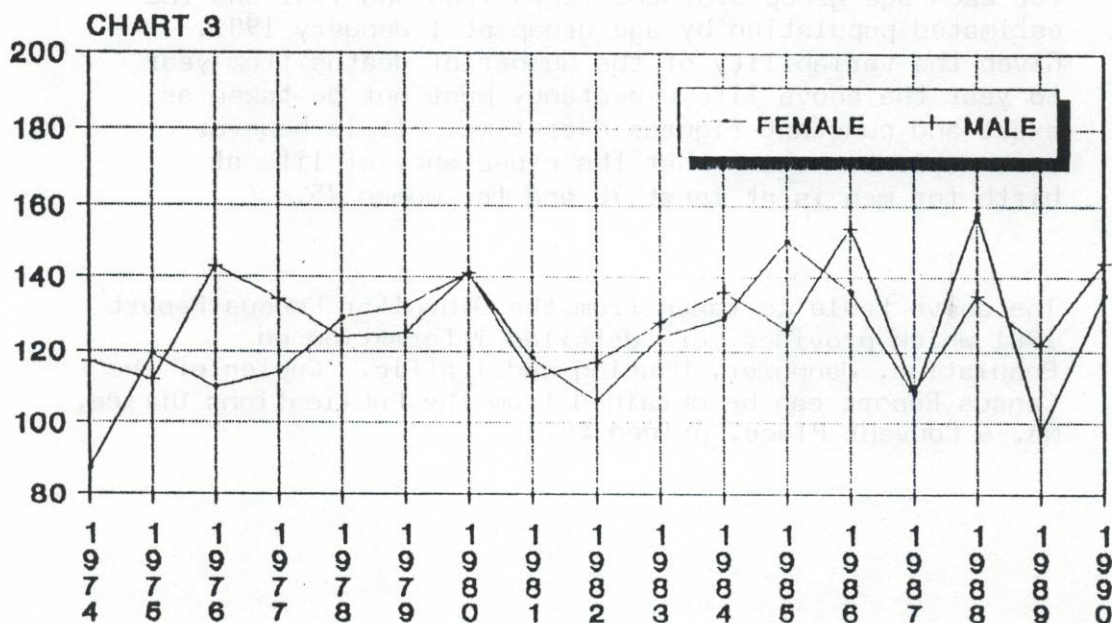

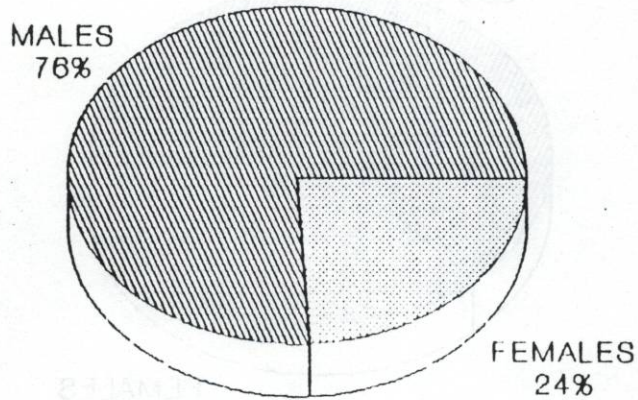

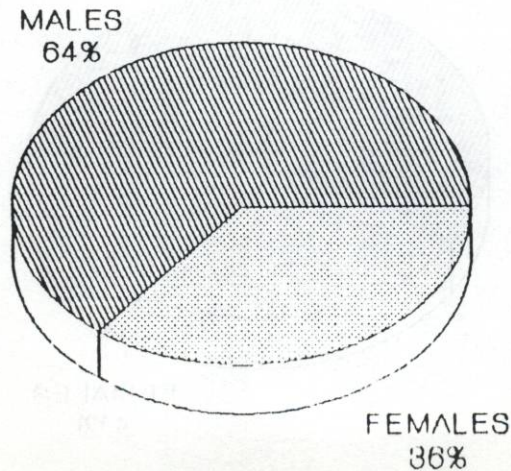

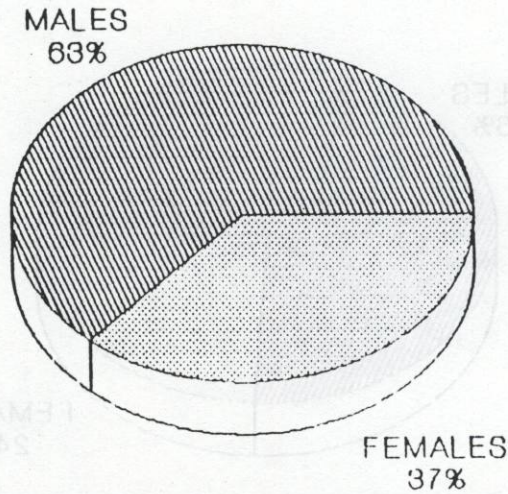

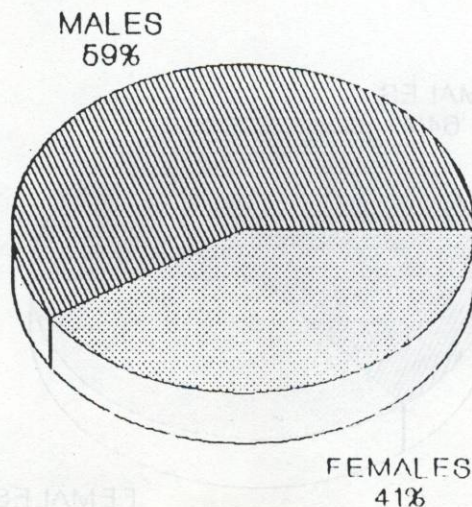

(JAN 1966-JAN 1990)

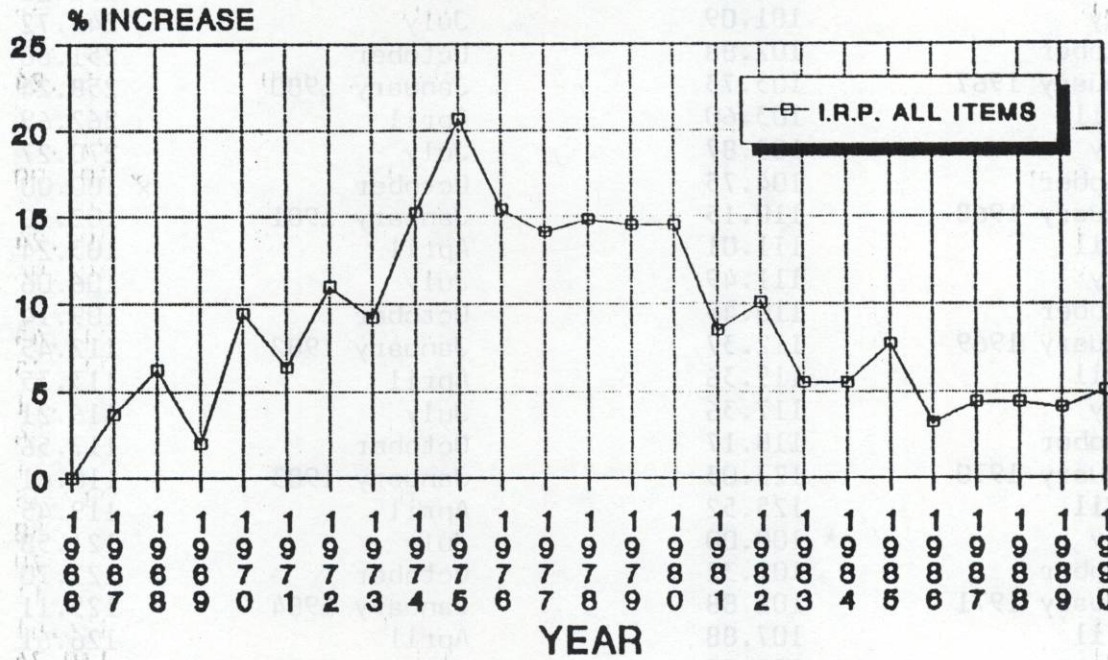
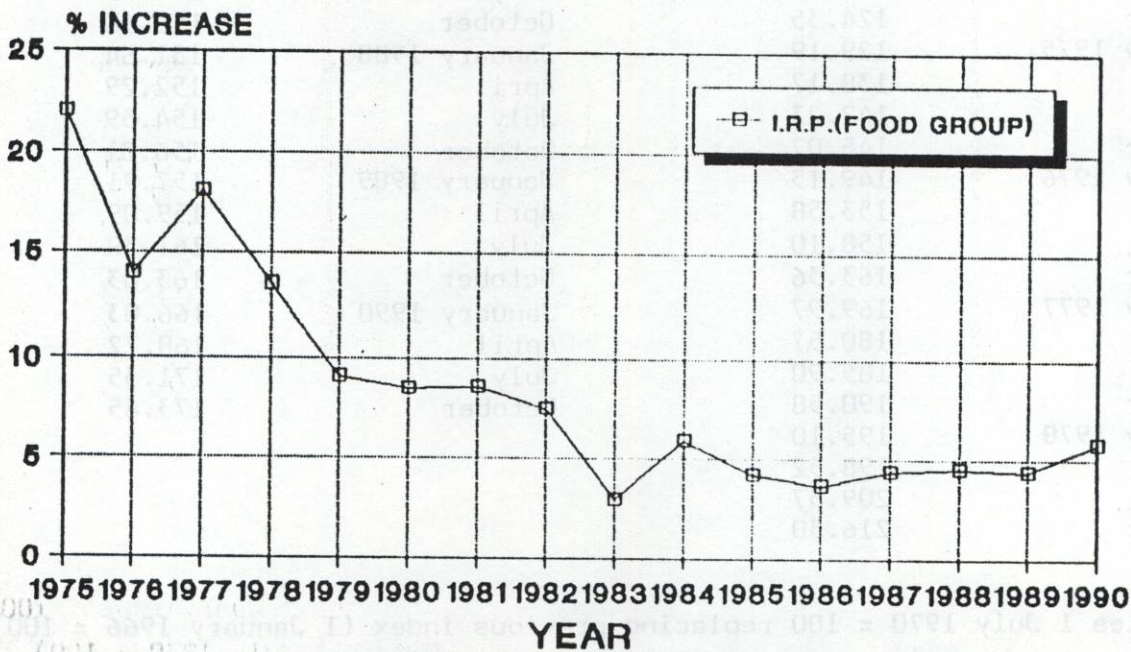

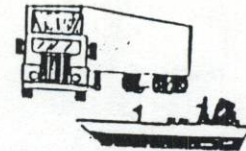

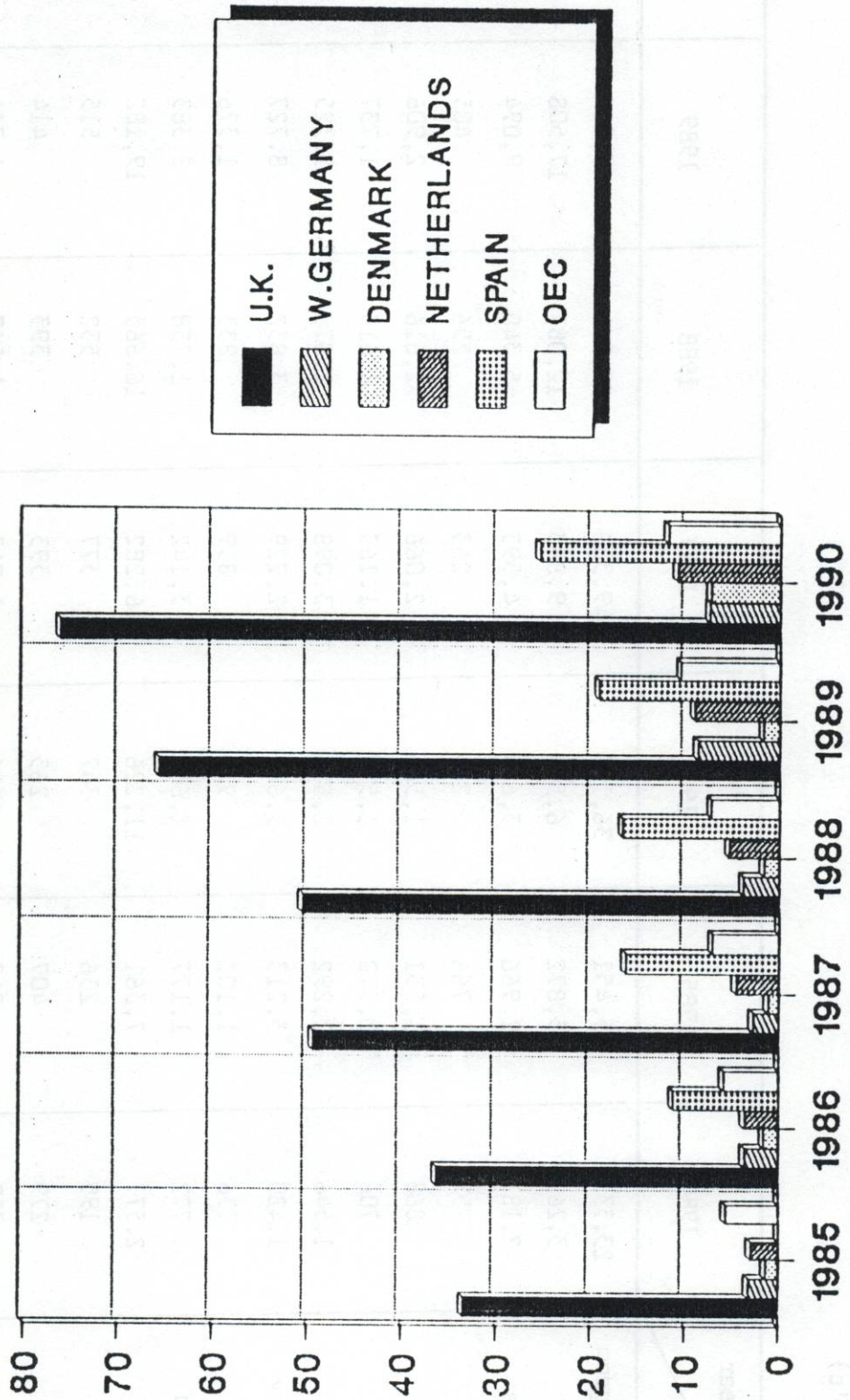

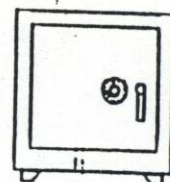

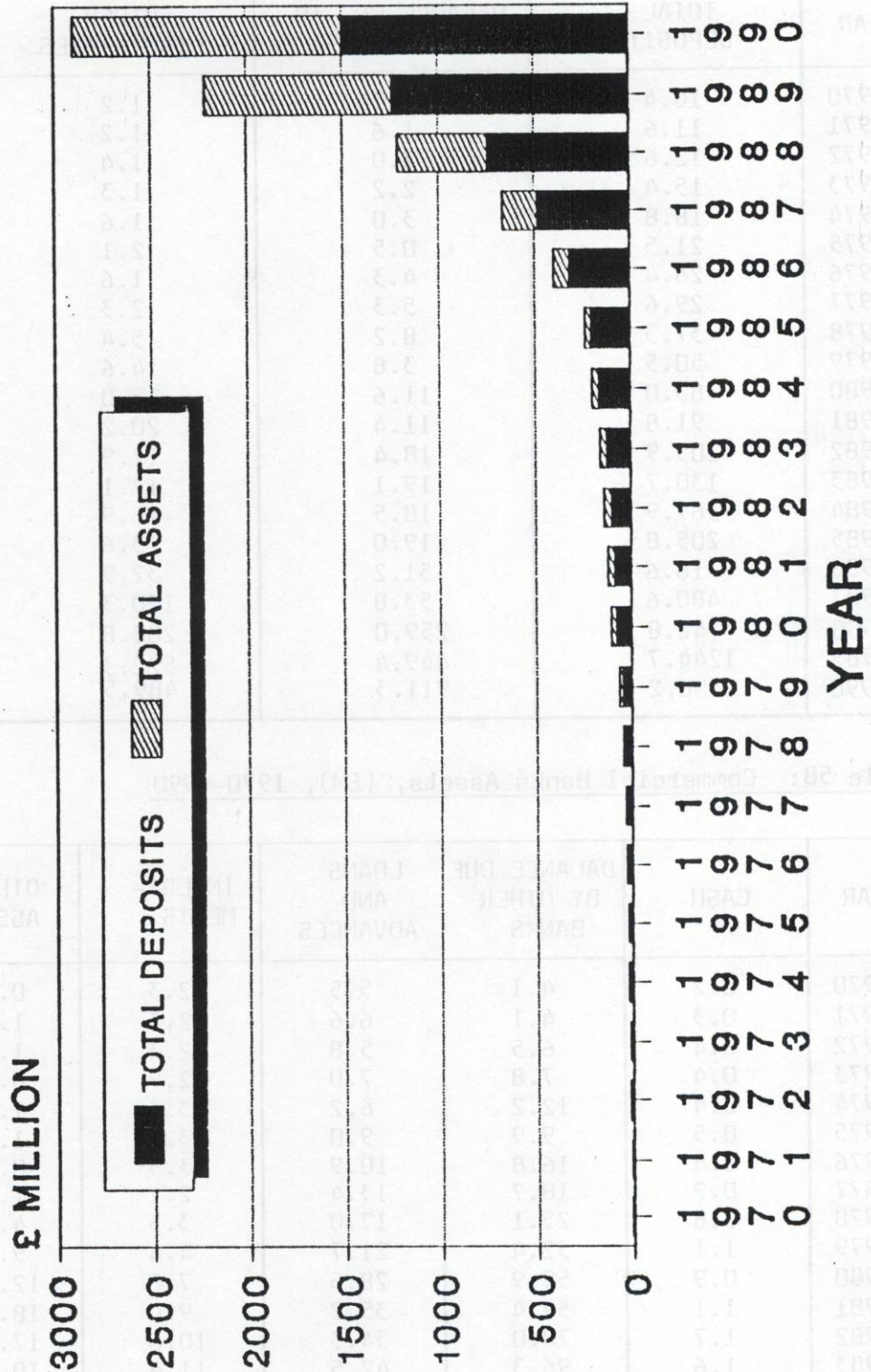

NEW REGISTRATIONS 1976-1990

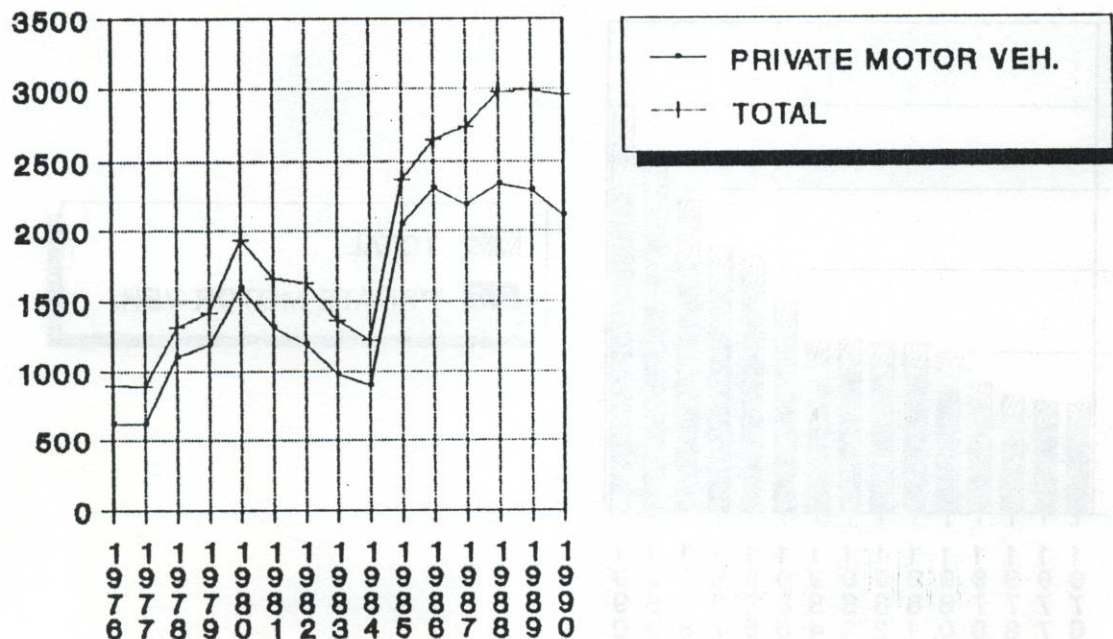


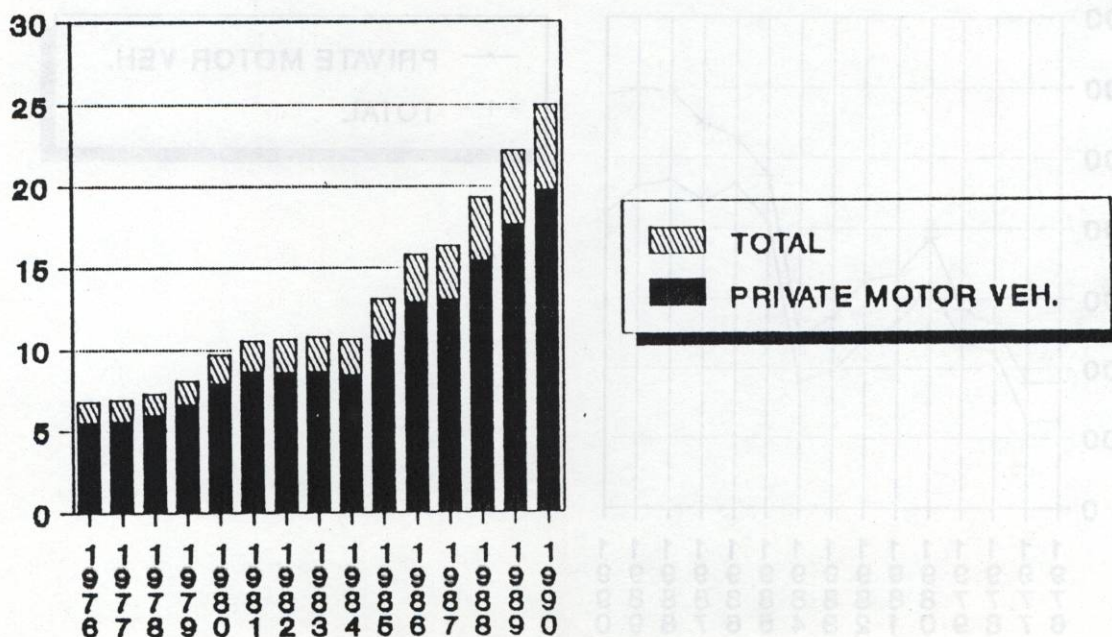

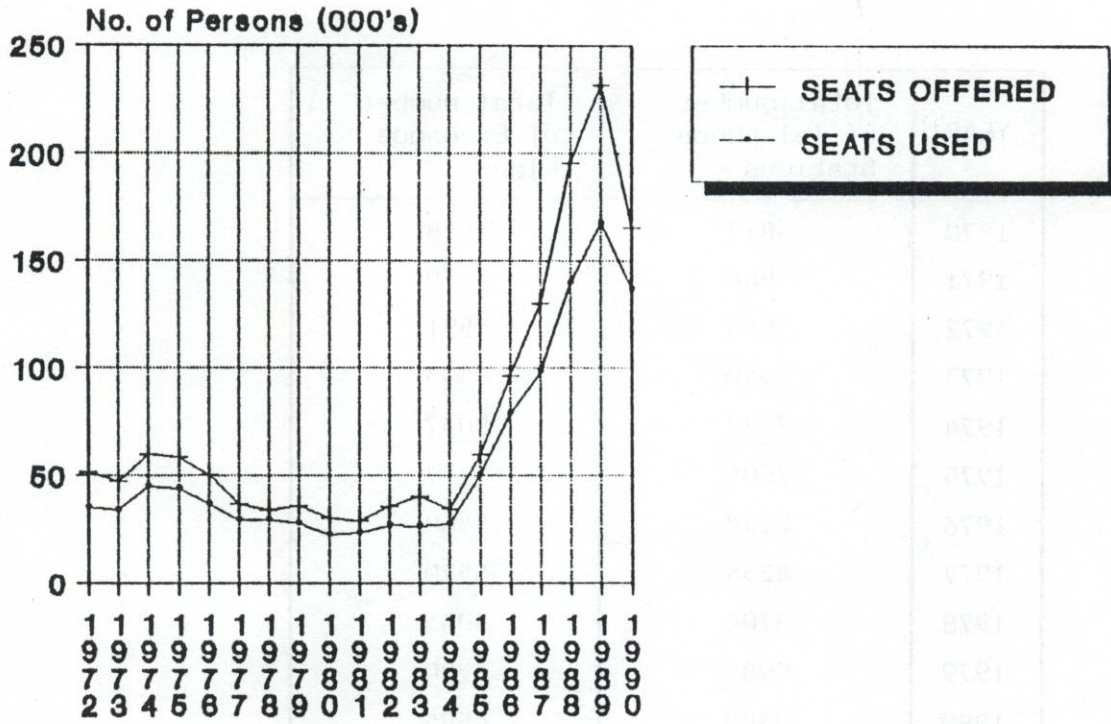
