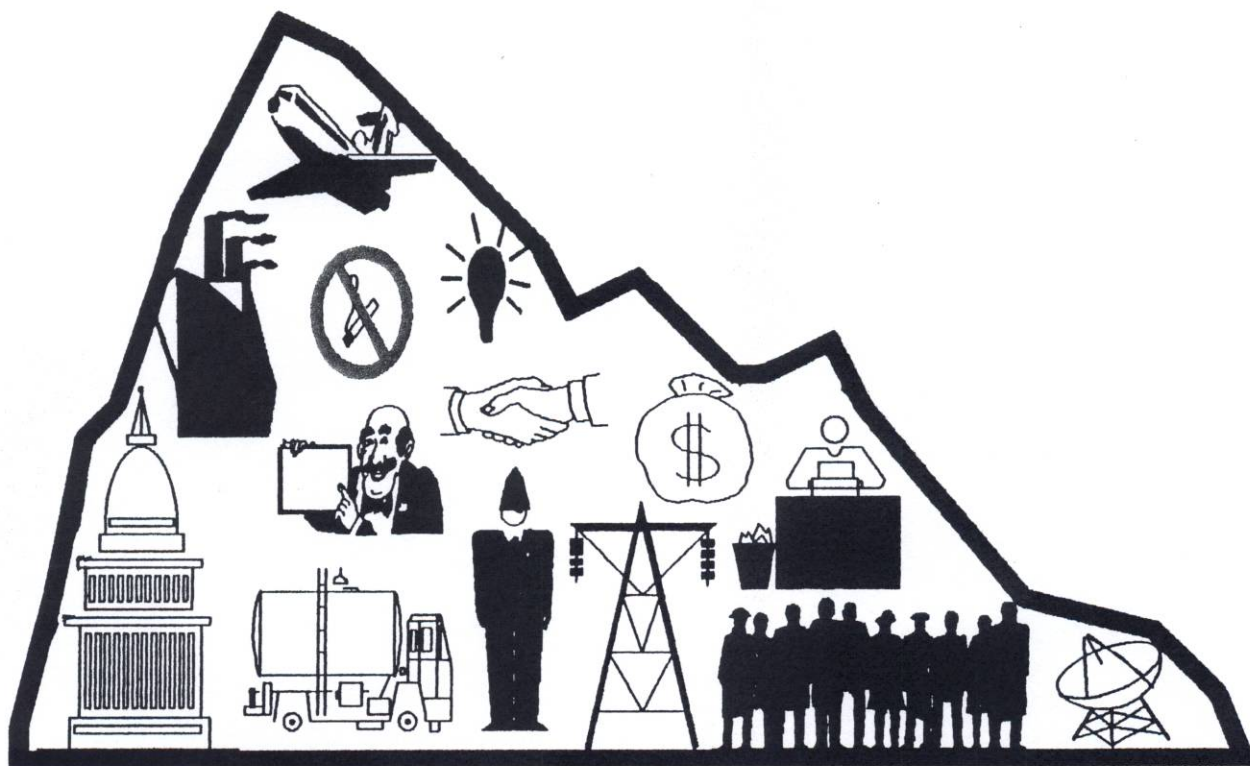

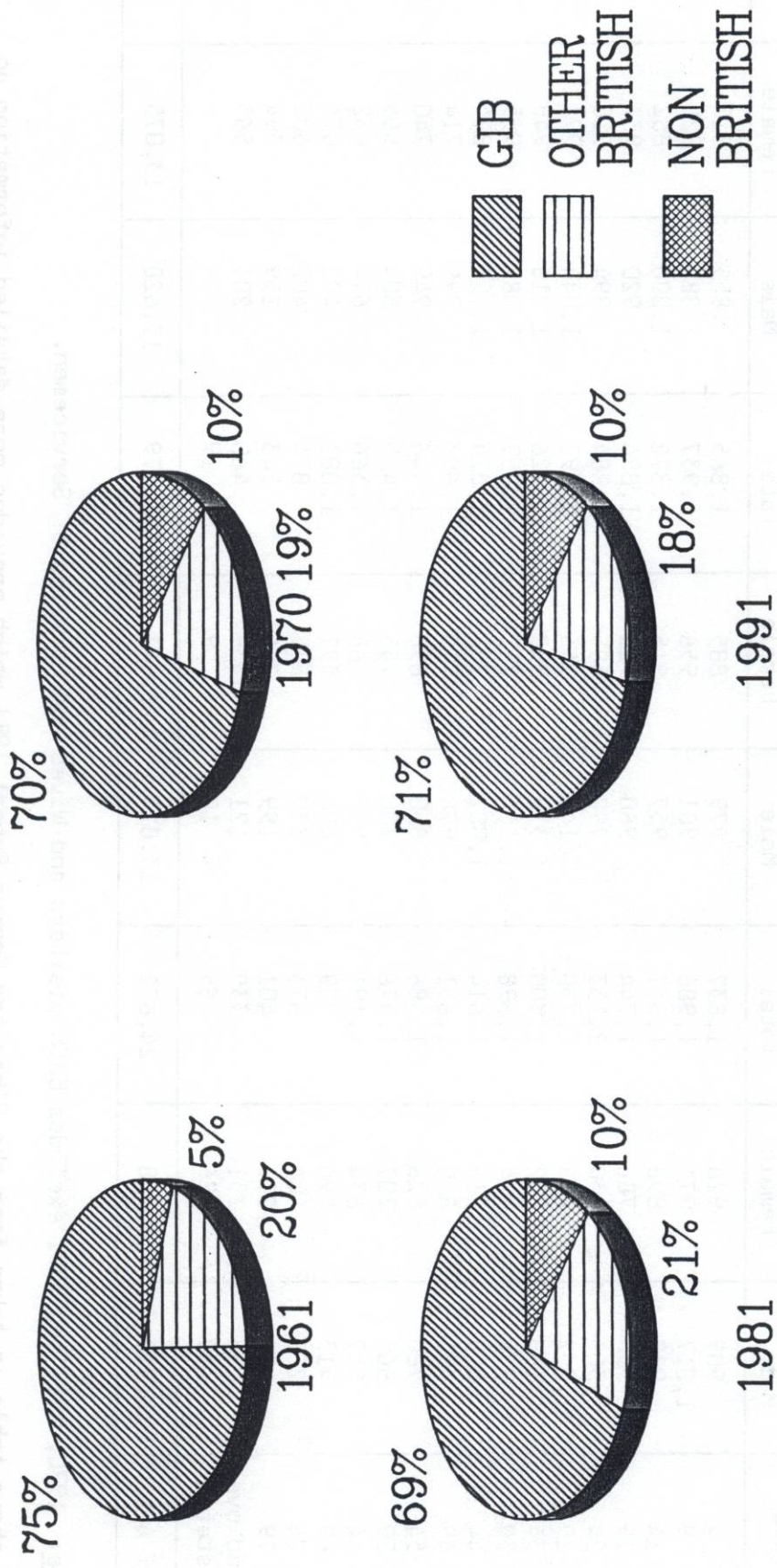

POPULATION BY AGE GROUP AND SEX 1991

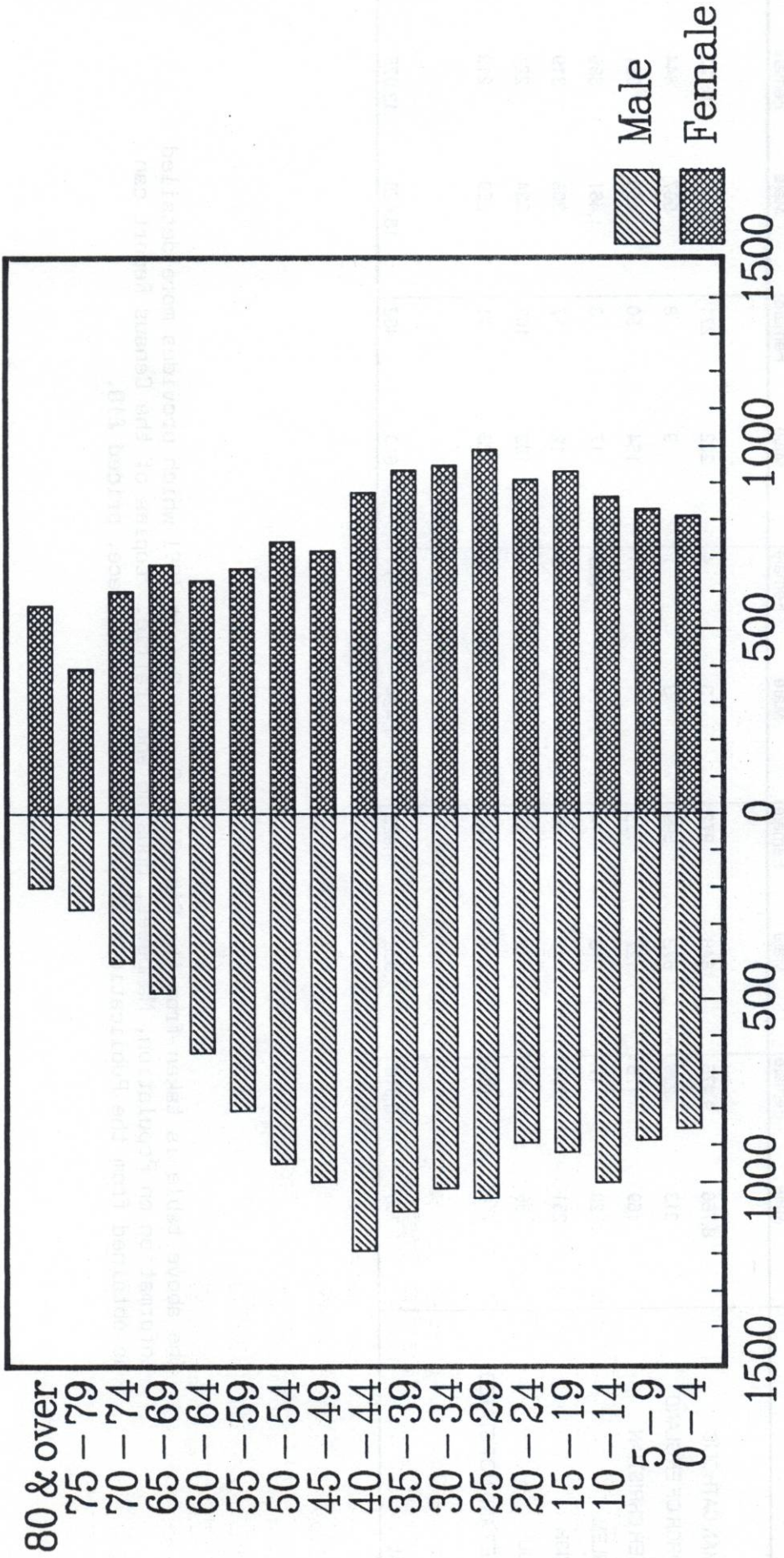

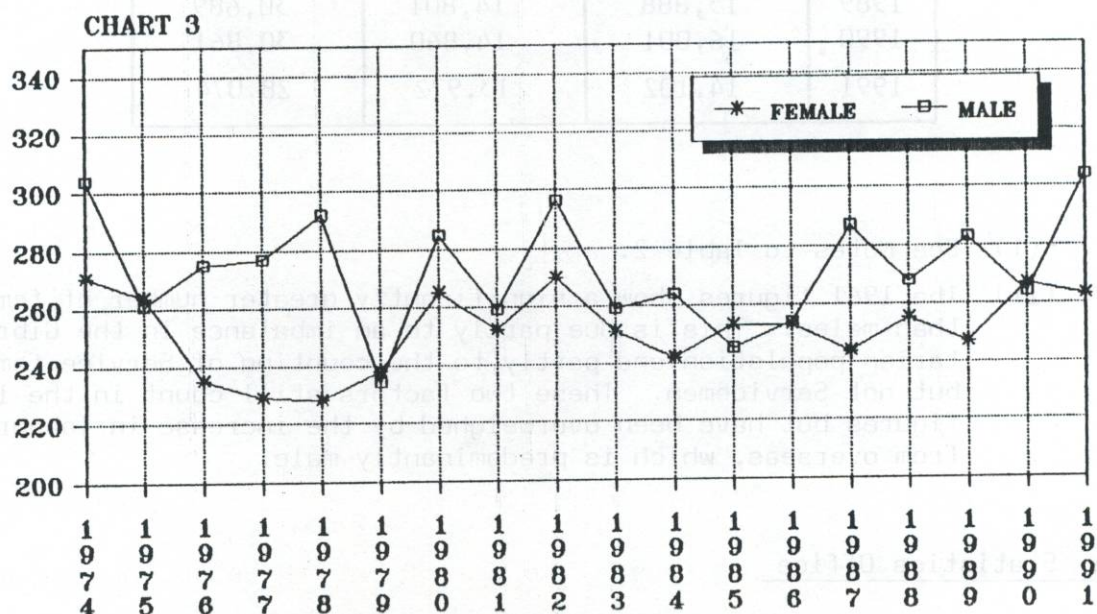

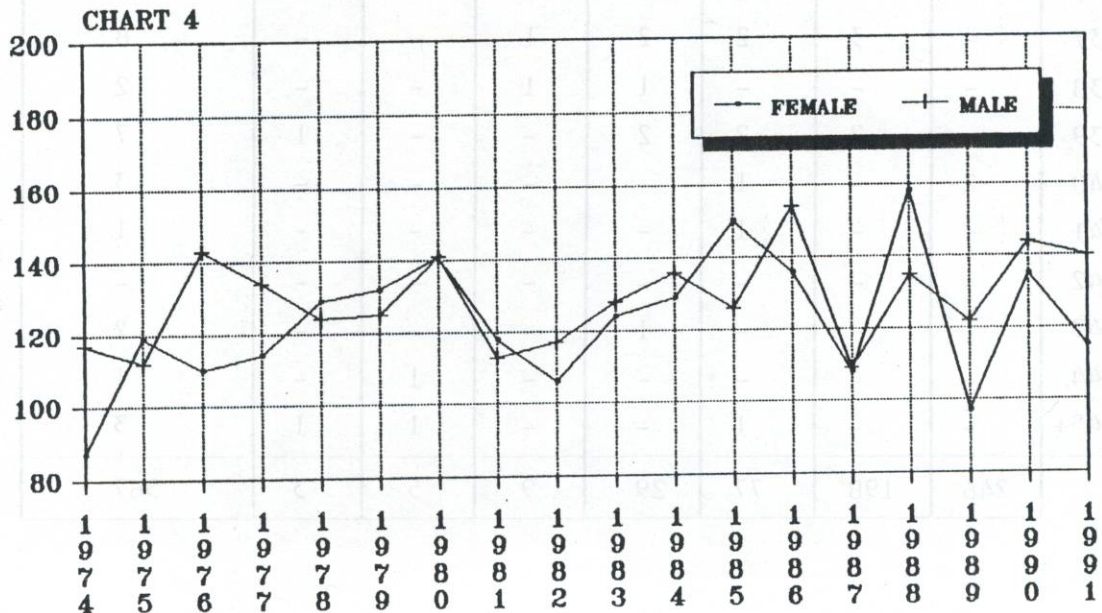

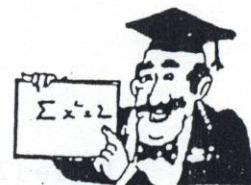

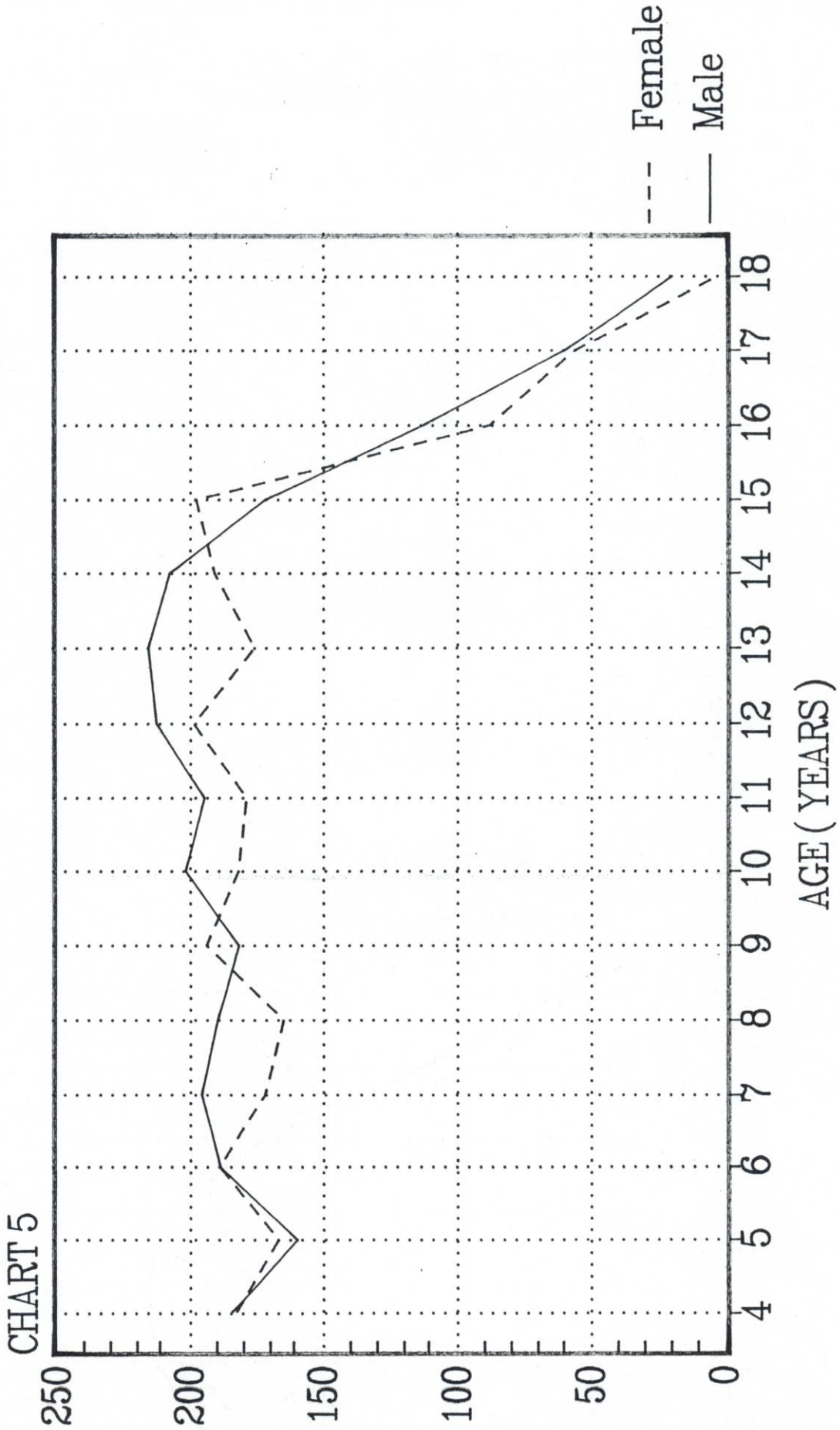

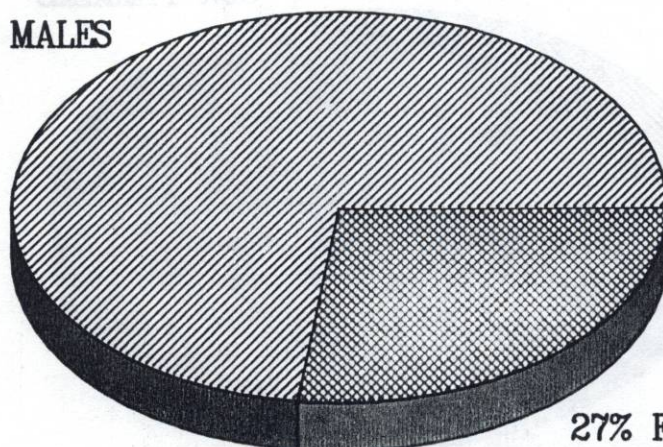

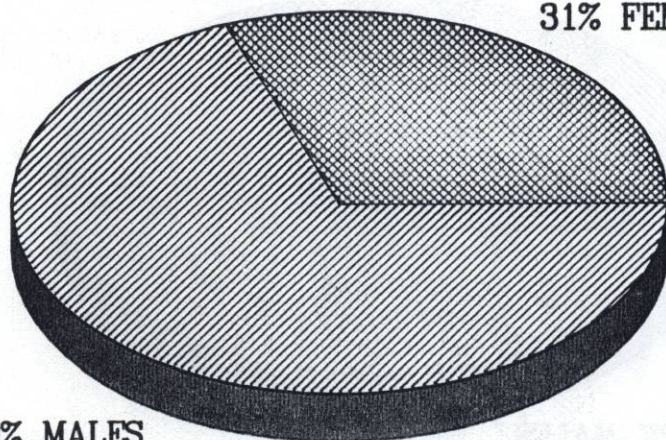

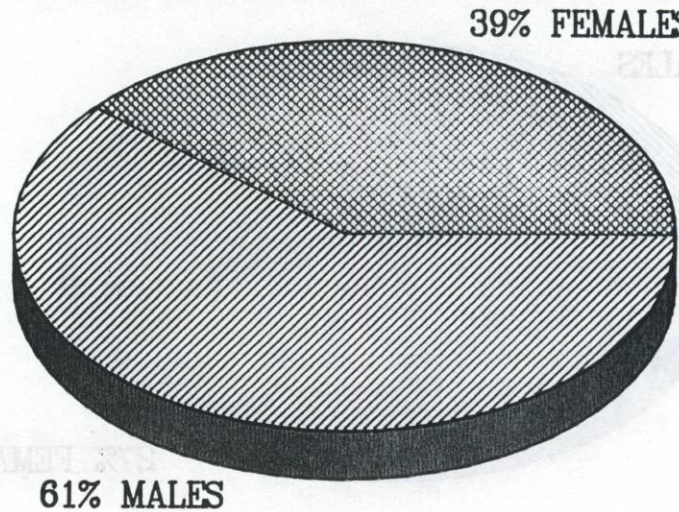

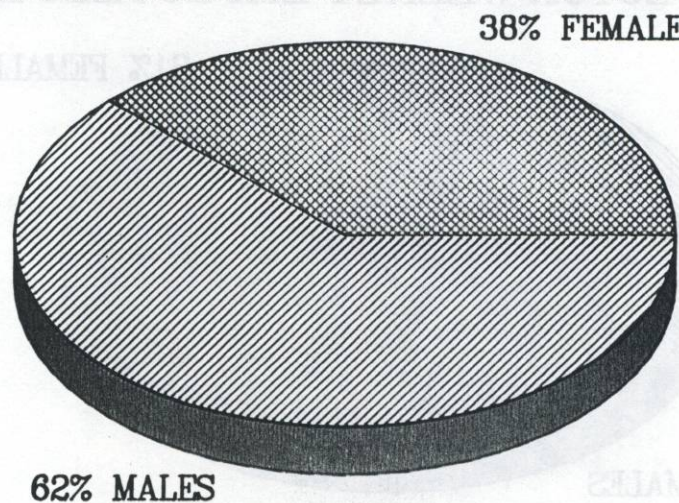

GIBRALTAR I.R.P. (ALL ITEMS) (JAN 1966–JAN 1991)

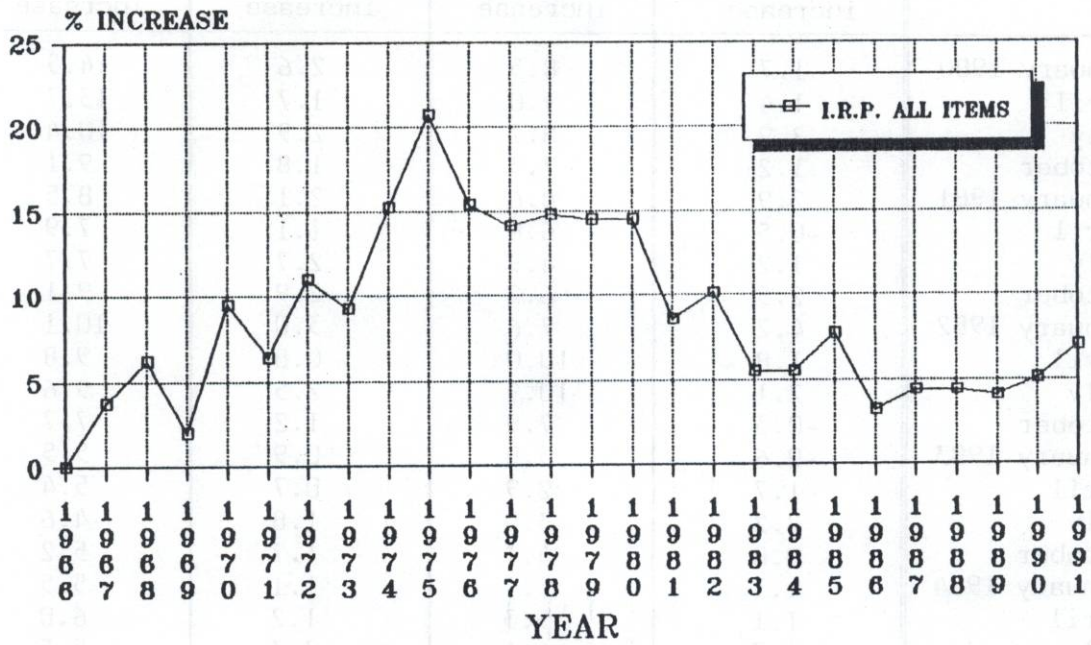
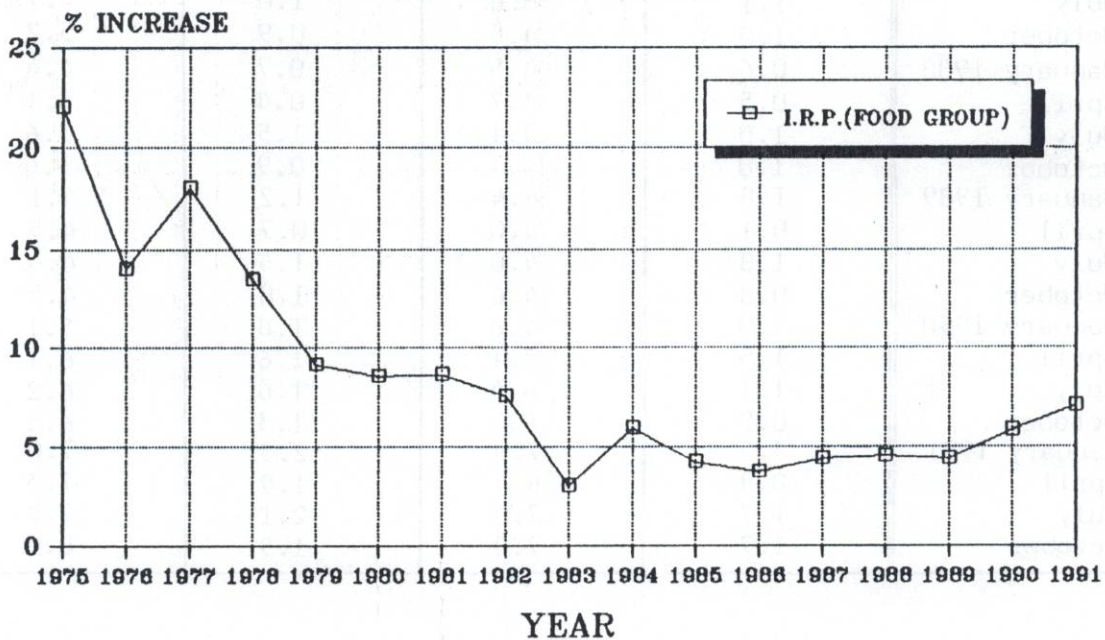

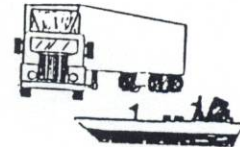

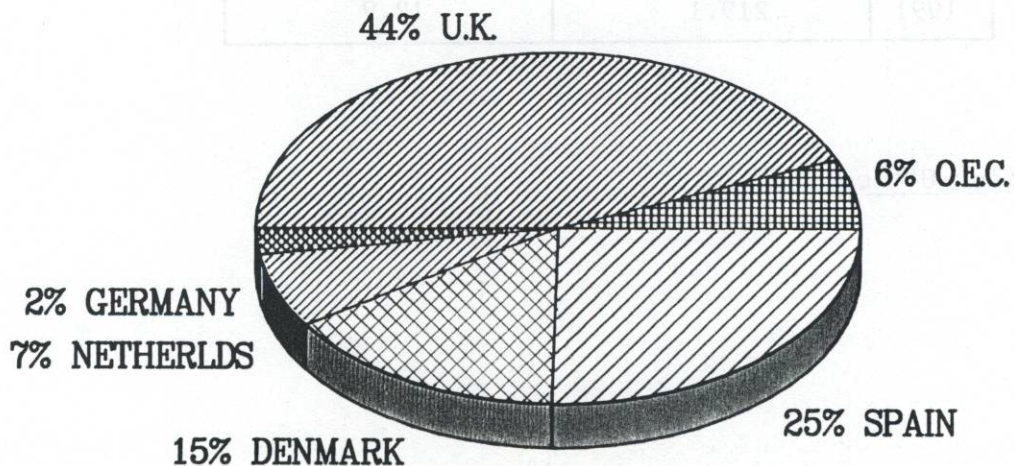

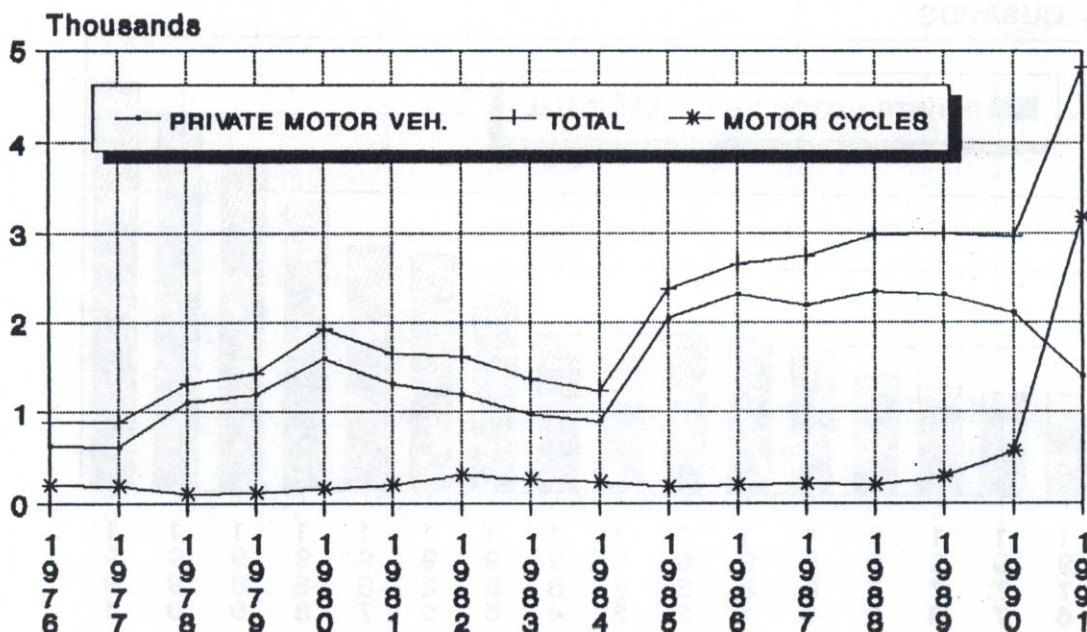


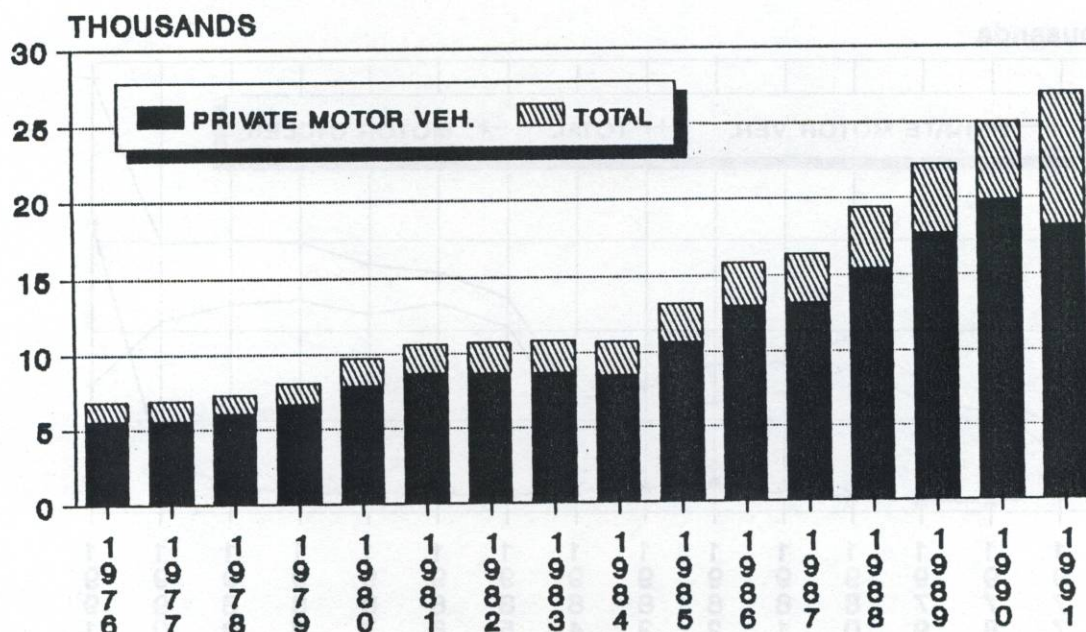
