

Civilian Population of Gibraltar by Nationality, 1961, 1970, 1981 & 1991



POPULATION BY AGE GROUP AND SEX 1991





















 (JAN 1966–JAN 1992)



 (JAN 1975–JAN 1992)













NEW REGISTRATIONS 1976-1992











