















## WEEKLY AND MONTHLY EMPLOYEES BY SEX

OFFICIAL SECTOR WEEKLY EMPLOYEES



( JAN 1966 - JAN 1996 )



( JAN 1975 - JAN 1996 )







BANKING STATISTICS 1970 - 1996







ALL ARRIVALS 1972 - 1996



**SCHEDULED 1972 - 1996**


