(a) (b)	You MUST bring us your valid British passport ; Your full birth certificate ; and Your naturalisation certificate if you have been naturalised as a British Overseas Territories citizen by virtue of your connection with Gibraltar.			
(c)	You MUST bring us a Certificate of Good Conduct from the Royal Gibraltar Police. If you owe any arrears of Income Tax, rent, rates or any other debt to Her Majesty's Government, you MUST bring evidence to show that you have made arrangements to repay this debt.			
(d)	Your knowledge of English will be assessed when you submit your application at our counter. In some cases we may ask you to attend a formal evaluation with a professional assessor.			
(e) & (f)	You MUST bring us a Certificate of Residence available at the Civil Status & Registration Office – Immigration Section. This is NOT required if you have been naturalised as a British Overseas Territories citizen by virtue of your connection with Gibraltar.
