****Primary Energy Efficiency Rating***

The primary energy efficiency rating is a measure of the overall efficiency of a building. The lower the rating (A being the lowest) the more energy efficient the building is and the lower the fuel bill will be.

****Environment Impact (CO²) Rating***

The environment impact rating is a measure of a building's impact on the environment in terms of carbon dioxide emissions. The lower the rating (A being the lowest), the less impact it has on the environment.
