PREFACE

This is the twenty-ninth Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the twenty-second under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.


The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

## 1. COVERAGE

1.1 In April 1984 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of employees. Since June 1984 the information received has been processed manually and after sending out three reminders to late respondents, the survey was finally closed in August 1984. The tabulation of the data was completed during September 1984. Response was good and only a small number of employers were excluded in the final tabulation.

## 2. A SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

2.1 The April 1984 survey shows a fall in the overall level of employment of around 3% to 4% (having regard to survey response), and a slight shift from full-time to part-time employment. The overall employment figure of 11,063 persons represents the lowest figure since 1972. The drop is mainly accounted for by the naval dockyard rundown and some contraction in the wholesale sector. At the time of writing this report, part of the drop in employment had already been offset by recruitment in the new ship-repair company at the dockyard; around 150 employees have been taken on during September 1984, of which over 100 were previously employed by the MOD.

2.2 There was no change in the level of average weekly earnings for full-time men (around £121 per week) between October 1983 and April 1984. There was a marginal earnings increase (2%) among full-time monthly-paid males (now at £743 on average per month).

2.3 Taking the level of average earnings of full-time weekly-paid Gibraltarians, it is estimated that average "take-home" pay, for a married couple with two children, fell in real terms by around 3.5% between April 1983 and April 1984 (see Table 16).

## Definitions

- i) "Official Employers" - The Gibraltar Government, Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Department of the Environment (DOE).
- ii) "Juvenile" - a person under 18 years of age.

- iv) Industries have been classified according to International Standard Industrial Classifications (I.S.I.C.)
- v) "Overtime" - work outside normal hours.
- vi) "Actual overtime hours" - some establishments show overtime hours in terms of equivalent paid hours. The actual overtime hours worked and not the equivalent hours are recorded in this report.
- vii) Occupations have been classified according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (I.S.C.O.) on the lines of the Classification set up for 1970 Census of Gibraltar. For the purpose of this report, occupations are grouped into six major categories.
- viii) Abbreviations:-
