PREFACE

This is the thirtieth Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the twenty-third under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who cooperated in this survey.

## COVERAGE

1.1 In October 1984 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of employees. Since December 1984 the information received has been processed manually and after sending out three reminders to late respondents, the survey was finally closed in January 1985. The tabulation of the data was completed during February 1985. Response was good and only a small number of employers were excluded in the final tabulation.

## 2. A SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

2.1 The October 1984 survey shows a slight increase in the overall level of employment compared to the April 1984 figure. The underlying downward trend in employment now appears to have been arrested. At the time of writing this report, recruitment in the new ship-repair company at the dockyard reached a total of around 570 employees of which just under 350 were previously employed by the Ministry of Defence. Some new additional employment opportunities have arisen following the full frontier opening last month.

2.2 The sectoral breakdown shows a shift in employment from the official employers (-224) to the private sector (+276). This reflects the reduction in employment in the naval dockyard and the increase in the number of employees in the commercial shiprepair company classified as being in the private sector.

2.3 Average weekly earnings for full-time men (around £126 per week) rose by some 4% between April 1984 and October 1984. There was a 6% earnings increase among full-time monthly-paid males. This reflects the July 1984 Pay Review (average 5% overall).

2.4 Taking the level of average earnings of full-time weekly-paid Gibraltarians, it is estimated that average "take-home" pay, for a married couple with two children rose marginally between October 1983 and October 1984. In real terms, this represents a drop of around 6% (see Table 16).

## Definitions

- i) "Official Employers" - The Gibraltar Government, Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Department of the Environment (DOE).
- ii) "Juvenile" - a person under 18 years of age.
- iii) The definition of "part-time" was generally left to the discretion of the employers.
- iv) Industries have been classified according to International Standard Industrial Classifications (I.S.I.C.)
- v) "Overtime" - work outside normal hours.
- vi) "Actual overtime hours" - some establishments show overtime hours in terms of equivalent paid hours. The actual overtime hours worked and not the equivalent hours are recorded in this report.
- vii) Occupations have been classified according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (I.S.C.C.) on the lines of the Classification set up for 1970 Census of Gibraltar. For the purpose of this report, occupations are grouped into six major categories.
- viii) Abbreviations:-
