PREFACE

This is the thirty-second Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the twenty-fifth under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970. With frontier normalisation, it was felt that the survey should regularly monitor the nature and size of the likely influx of persons residing in Spain but who will be employed in Gibraltar. These employees are normally classified as "frontier workers." The Statistics (Employment Survey) (Amendment) Order 1985 was therefore introduced with effect from the 1st April 1985 to include an additional question on country of residence of employees.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who co-operated in this survey.

1. COVERAGE

1.1 In October 1985 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of employees. Since December 1985 the information received has been processed manually and after sending out three reminders to late respondents, the survey was finally closed in January 1986. The tabulation of the data was completed during February 1986. Response was good and only a small number of employers were excluded in the final tabulation.

2. SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

- 2.1 The October 1985 Survey shows an upward trend in employment mainly in ship-repairing at the commercial yard, the tourist related industries and the financial services. The survey recorded a total of 11626 persons in employment. This represents an increase of 335 over the level recorded in April 1985.
- 2.2 The main employment trends during this six-monthly period can be summarised as follows:-
 - (a) employment in the new commercial shiprepair company increased by some 150 between April and October 1985, rising to a total of 750 by October 1985;
 - (b) employment in the private sector as a whole including the commercial yard has risen by some 350 employees since April 1985. Having regard to survey response, and slight seasonal fluctuations in employment, it is estimated that between 350 to 450 new private sector jobs have been created, excluding those in the new shiprepair company, since October 1984. This largely reflects the short-term effects of the opening of the frontier. The increases were in the retail industry (notably the food sector), the hotel and catering sector and, in financial services;
 - (c) apart from the commercial shiprepair, the financial services recorded the highest increase in employment (+71) since April 1985;
 - (d) the number of Spanish employees rose by 114 compared to April 1985, to a total of 232;

- (e) a total of 286 employees were classified as "frontier workers" compared to 110 in April 1985. This includes 158 Spaniards, 63 Uh nationals and 46 Gibraltarians. The majority (273) were employed in the private sector, mainly in the hotel and catering trade and the construction industry;
- 2.3 Average weekly earnings for full-time men rose by over 8% between April 1985 and October 1985. This is partly accounted for by a slight increase in the level of overtime and by the settlement of the 1985 Pay Review in certain areas. The increase however is mainly attributable to the fact that average weekly earnings for full-time men in the private sector rose by over 12%. This has meant that the parity established between average weekly earnings in the official and private sectors in April 1985 has been broken in favour of the latter. This is mainly the result of the re-classification of the shiprepair activity from the official to the private sector. However, it also reflects higher earnings levels elsewhere in the private sector, notably in the wholesale/retail trade and the transport sector.
- 2.4 Taking the level of average earnings of full-time weekly-paid Gibraltarians, it is estimated that average "take home" pay for a married couple with two children, rose in real terms by 4.5% between October 1984 and October 1985.
