



PREFACE

This is the thirty-third Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the twenty-sixth under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who co-operated in this survey.

1. COVERAGE

1.1 In April 1986 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of employees. Since June 1986 the information received has been processed manually and after sending out three reminders to late respondents, the survey was finally closed in August 1986 and tabulation completed during September 1986. Response was good and only a small number of employers were excluded in the final tabulation.

2. SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

2.1 The April 1986 Survey shows an increase in the overall level of employment mainly in the Building and Construction Industry, ship-repairing at the commercial yard and in the financial services. The survey recorded a total of 11869 persons in employment. This represents an increase of some 240 over the level recorded in October 1985.

2.2 The main employment trends during this six-monthly period can be summarised as follows:-

- (a) employment in the commercial yard increased by some 65 between October 1985 and April 1986, rising to a total of 815 by April 1986;
- (b) employment in the private sector as a whole, including the commercial yard, rose by around 260 employees since October 1985;
- (c) the Building and Construction industry recorded the highest increase in employment (+81) since October 1985;
- (d) the Education Services show a decrease in part-timers of about 140. This is mainly as a result of the re-classification of charwomen from part-time to full-time employment;
- (e) the number of Spanish employees rose by 152 compared to October 1985, to a total of 384;

(f) a total of 370 employees were classified as "frontier workers" compared to 286 in October 1985. This includes 254 Spaniards, 67 U.K. nationals and 38 Gibraltarians. The majority (356) were employed in the private sector, mainly in the hotel and the construction industries.

2.3 Average earnings for full-time adult men increased marginally from £133.99 in October 1985 to £134.05 in April 1986. Earnings in the private sector fell, however, mainly as a result of a decrease in overtime levels. Average weekly earnings in the official sector increased by 8.7% reflecting both the settlement in full of the 1985 Pay Review and on increases in overtime earnings of some 20%. Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in April 1986 were £849.71 for adult males and £565.05 for adult females, a rise of 2.8% and 5.3% respectively compared to October 1985. Again this reflects settlement of the 1985 Pay Review.

2.4 Taking the level of average earnings of full-time weekly-paid Gibraltarians, it is estimated that average "take home" pay for a married couple with two children, rose in real terms by 5.9% between April 1985 and April 1986.
