

Employment Survey Report April 1989

PREFACE

This is the thirty-ninth Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the thirty-second under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who co-operated in this survey.

1. COVERAGE

- 1.1 In April 1989 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. The information received was processed manually and after sending out three reminders to late respondents, the Survey was closed in July 1989. Tabulation was completed during February 1990. The response rate was generally good and only a small number of employers were excluded in the final report.
- 1.2 The industry classification has been revised and now follows more closely the specifications of the C.S.O. "Standard Industrial Classification" as applied in the U.K.

2. SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

- 2.1 The April 1989 Survey shows an increase in the overall level of employment from 13,610 in October 1988 to 13,974 (+2.7%).
- 2.2 Other employment trends during this six-monthly period can be summarised as follows:
 - (a) The level of employment almost reached the 14,000 mark totalling 13,974.
 - (b) Employment at the commercial shiprepair yard continued to fall to marginally over 400 as a result of the process of restructure.
 - (c) Employment in Banking, Finance and Insurance stood at some 1,400 thus representing the leading private sector industry in terms of employment.
 - (d) The largest increase in employment by occupation was recorded in the Professional, Technical and related grades where numbers rose from 1,554 in October 1988 to 1,746 in April 1989 (+12.4%).
- 2.3 Average weekly earnings for full-time adult men increased from £172.23 in October 1988 to £182.61 in April 1989 (+6.0%) with the level of overtime hours worked rising from 8.5 in October 1988 to 10.3 in April 1989. Earnings in the Private Sector increased by 3.7% over the period from £178.28 to £184.96 and by 6.3% in respect of monthly-paid employees from £1,031,69 in October 1988 to

- £1,096.66 in April 1989. Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in April 1989 were £1,157.21 for adult males and £750.24 for adult females.
- 2.4 Taking the level of average earnings of full-time weekly-paid Gibraltarians, it is estimated that net "take-home" pay for a married couple with two children, rose in real terms by 8.7% between April 1988 and April 1989.

Definitions

- (i) "Official Employers" The Gibraltar Government, Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Department of the Environment (DOE).
- (ii) "Frontier Worker" An employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (iii) "Juvenile" A person under 18 years of age.
- (iv) The definition of "part-time" was generally left to the discretion of the employers.
- (v) Industries have been classified according to International Standard Industrial Classifications (I.S.I.C.)
- (vi) "Overtime" Work outside normal hours.
- (vii) "Actual overtime hours" Some establishments show overtime hours in terms of equivalent paid hours. The <u>actual</u> overtime hours worked and not the equivalent hours are recorded in this report.
- (viii) Occupations have been classified according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (I.S.C.O.) on the lines of the Classification set up for 1970 Census of Gibraltar. For the purpose of this report, occupations are grouped into six major categories.
