

EMPLOYMENT SURVEY REPORT APRIL 1991

PREFACE

This is the forty-third Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the thirty-sixth under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who co-operated in this survey.

COVERAGE

1. In April 1991 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. The information received was processed through computer and the response rate was generally good with only a small number of employers excluded from the final report.

SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

- 1. The April 1991 Survey shows an increase in the overall level of employment from 14,219 in October 1990 to 14,782 (4.0%).
- 2. The main employment trends during this six-monthly period can be summarised as follows:
 - (a) The level of employment is nearing the 15,000 mark totalling 14,782.
 - (b) Employment in the Construction Industry (Table 12) stood at 1,956 in April 1991 compared with 1,261 in October 1990 (+55%) becoming the leading private sector industry in terms of employment.
 - (c) The largest increase in numbers employed by occupation was recorded in respect of Production, Construction, etc. workers rising from 4,427 in October 1990 to 4,986 in April 1991 (+12.6%).
- 3. Average weekly earnings for full-time adult men increased from £197.77 in October 1990 to £198.68 in April 1991 (+0.5%) with the level of overtime hours worked falling from 6.7 in October 1990 to 5.9 in April 1991. Earnings for these male workers in the Private Sector rose by 2.2% over the period from £195.88 to £200.23 and rose by 9.3% in respect of monthly-paid male employees from £1,208.11 in October 1990 to £1,291.74 in April 1991. Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in April 1991 were £1,387.36 for adult males and £890.23 for adult females.

- (i) "Official Employers" The Gibraltar Government, Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Department of the Environment (DOE).
- (ii) "Frontier Worker" An employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (iii) "Juvenile" A person under 18 years of age.
 - (iv) The definition of "part-time" was generally left to the discretion of the employers.
 - (v) Industries have been classified according to International Standard Industrial Classifications (I.S.I.C.)
 - (vi) "Overtime" Work outside normal hours.
- (vii) "Actual overtime hours" Some establishments show overtime hours in terms of equivalent paid hours. The <u>actual</u> overtime hours worked and not the equivalent hours are recorded in this report.
- (viii) Occupations have been classified according to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (I.S.C.O.) on the lines of the Classification set up for 1970 Census of Gibraltar. For the purpose of this report, occupations are grouped into six major categories.
