#### **PREFACE**

This is the forty-forth Employment Survey conducted in Gibraltar and the thirty-seventh under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

I must record my thanks to all those employers who co-operated in this survey.

#### COVERAGE

1. In October 1991 all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. The information received was processed through computer and the response rate was generally good with only a small number of employers excluded from the final report.

## SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

- 1. The October 1991 Survey shows an increase in the overall level of employment from 14,782 in April 1991 to 15,098 (2.1%).
- 2. The main employment trends during this six-monthly period can be summarised as follows:
  - (a) For the first time the level of employment has broken through the 15,000 mark.
  - (b) Employment in the Construction Industry (Table 12) stood at 2,541 in October 1991 compared with 1,956 in April 1991 (+30%) remaining the leading private sector industry in terms of employment.
  - (c) The largest percentage in numbers employed by occupation was recorded in respect of Admin and Managerial workers rising from 1,123 in April 1991 to 1,284 in October 1991 (+14.3%).
- Average weekly earnings for full-time adult men increased from £198.68 in April 1991 to £224.54 in October 1991 (+13.0%) with the level of overtime hours worked increasing from 5.9 in April 1991 to 7.6 in October 1991. This increase is mainly due to an increase in overtime earnings. The basic rate per hour has increased by 7.7% from April 1991 to October 1991. Earnings for

these male workers in the Private Sector rose by 9.1% over the period from £200.23 to £218.40 and rose by 1.5% in respect of monthly-paid male employees from £1,291.74 in April 1991 to £1,311.73 in October 1991. Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in October 1991 were £1,408.44 for adult males and £968.81 for adult females.

### Definitions

- (i) "Official Employers" The Gibraltar Government, Ministry of Defence (MOD) and the Department of the Environment (DOE).
- (ii) "Frontier Worker" An employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (iii) "Juvenile" A person under 18 years of age.
  - (iv) The definition of "part-time" was generally left to the discretion of the employers.
