PREFACE

These are the fifty-forth and fifty-fifth Employment Surveys conducted in Gibraltar and the forty-sixth and forty-seventh under the Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order 1971 as Amended) 1970.

The purpose of such surveys is to obtain up-to-date information regarding trends in employment and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar. This information assists the Gibraltar Government with decisions on labour matters and is also useful for the compilation of National Accounts for Gibraltar.

COVERAGE

1. During 1998 returns were received from all known employers in respect of their employees, the information received being processed through computer. The response rate was good with only a small number of employers excluded from the final report.

SUMMARY OF THE RESULTS

1. The employment statistics as at October 1997 show a decrease in the overall level of employment from 13,000 in April 1997 to 12,762 (-1.8%) followed by a small rise from 12,762 to 12,840 in April 1998 (+0.6%).

2. The main employment trends during the period covered by this report can be summarised as follows:

(a) Employment in the Construction Industry (Tables 12A & 12B) registered a large increase during the period in question, from 1,248 in April 1997 to 1,529 in October 1997 (+22.5%), also increased marginally from 1,529 to 1,538 in April 1998 (+0.6%).

(b) During the same period employment in Banking, Finance and Insurance has shown a small increase while Retail Trade continued to decrease from 1,561 in April 1997 to 1,538 in April 1998 (-1.5%).

(c) The largest percentage increase in numbers employed, by occupational group in the period April 1997 to October 1997, was recorded in respect of Professional, Technical and Related Workers rising from 1,694 in April 1997 to 1,896 in October 1997 (+11.9%). The Sales Workers group rose from 1,267 in October 1997 to 1,334 in April 1998 (+5.3%).

3(a) Average weekly earnings for full-time adult men rose from £226.82 in April 1997 to £233.03 in October 1997 (+2.7%), and increased further from £233.03 to £239.05 in April 1998 (+2.6%).

(b) Earnings for these male workers in the Private Sector increased by 1.3% over the period, from £220.30 in April 1997 to £223.16 in October 1997 and increased further by 4.0% from £223.16 to £232.08 in April 1998.

(c) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid adult male employees dropped by 2.3% from £1,542.17 in April 1997 to £1,507.06 in October 1997 but increased by 3.9% from £1,507.06 to £1,565.82 in April 1998.

(d) Average earnings for full-time monthly-paid employees in October 1997 were £1,538.36 for adult males and £1,171.38 for adult females, rising to £1,599.48 for adult males and rising to £1,216.81 for adult females in April 1998.
