## PREFACE

The Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order as Amended) 1970 requires that the Government Statistician prepares a report for the House of Assembly. This is the fiftieth such survey the purpose of which is to obtain information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar.

In December 2000, all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. Two reminders were sent to late respondents. As with previous surveys, the response rate was good and only a low percentage of small employers were excluded from the final report.

The industry classification follows that of the UK's Standard Industrial Classification (SIC 92) and occupational groups now conform to the UK's Standard Occupational Classification (SOC 2000). Once again there has been some delay in producing this report as a result of the extensive data validation checks which were introduced following the changes applied to the software program for the October 1999 Employment Survey analysis. These have been reviewed and I am satisfied that data compilation and validation will proceed in a faster and more accurate manner. It is my firm intention to achieve a completion date not exceeding six months from the date of the conduct of employment surveys in the future, starting with the October 2001 Survey.

I must express my thanks to all employers for their continued co-operation in the conduct of this survey.

## SURVEY SUMMARY

1. The employment statistics show an increase in the level of employee jobs from 12,936 in October 1999 to 13,381 (+3.4%) in October 2000.
2. The main employment trends during the period covered by this report can be summarised as follows:
  - (a) Average annual earnings in respect of all employee jobs increased by +1.9%, from £14,874.91 in October 1999 to £15,164.52 in October 2000. The total number of employee jobs recorded was the highest since October 1993 and, other than in April 1997, surpassed the level of 13,000 for the first time since then.
  - (b) The largest increase in the level of employee jobs by industry was that registered in respect of Other Services. The number of jobs recorded for this industry increased from 907 in October 1999 to 1,099 in October 2000, a rise of +21.2%. This increase once again reflects the growing presence, in employment terms, of the gambling firms over the period with private sector employee jobs in respect of this industry increasing from 850 in October 1999 to 1,049 in October 2000 (+23.4%).
  - (c) The number of employee jobs recorded in respect of the private sector increased by +3.8%, from 9,164 in October 1999 to 9,509 in October 2000, with the number of jobs in the Financial Intermediation industry increasing over the period from 1,066 to 1,106 (+3.8%).
  - (d) During the period, the total number of weekly-paid full-time adult employee jobs fell from 4,425 in October 1999 to 4,367 in October 2000 (-1.3%). However, there was an increase in the number of monthly-paid full-time adult employee jobs from 6,314 to 6,843 (+8.4%) over the same period. The total number of adult full-time employee jobs increased from 10,739 in October 1999 to 11,210 in October 2000 (+4.4%).
  - (e) Average weekly earnings in respect of full-time adult male employee jobs fell marginally from £262.75 in October 1999 to £258.39 in October 2000 (-1.7%), with earnings in the Private Sector increasing by +1.5%. The number of full-time weekly-paid adult male jobs fell from 3,307 to 3,276 (-0.9%) with jobs in the Construction industry decreasing by - 4.7%.
  - (f) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid full-time adult male jobs increased by +1.9%, from £1,856.56 to £1,892.56 over the period. The earnings of monthly-paid full-time female jobs increased by +3.0%, from £1,321.52 to £1,361.63. The number of full-time monthly-paid adult jobs recorded in the Other Services Industry group increased by +35.0% in respect of males and by +46.5% in respect of females as a result of increasing employment within the gambling firms.
