## PREFACE

The Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order as Amended) 1970 requires that the Government Statistician prepares a report for the House of Assembly. This is the fifty-first such survey the purpose of which is to obtain information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar.

In October 2001, all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. Two reminders were sent to late respondents. As with previous surveys, the response rate was good and only a low percentage of small employers were excluded from the final report.

I must express my thanks to all employers for their continued co-operation in the conduct of this survey.

## SURVEY SUMMARY

1. The employment statistics show an increase in the level of employee jobs from 13,381 in October 2000 to 13,931 (+4.1%) in October 2001, the highest recorded since April 1993.
2. The main employment trends during the period covered by this report can be summarised as follows:
  - (a) Average annual earnings in respect of all employee jobs increased by +6.8%, from £15,164.52 in October 2000 to £16,199.42 in October 2001.
  - (b) The largest increase in the level of employee jobs by industry was that registered in the Construction industry. The number of jobs recorded for this industry increased from 1,401 in October 2000 to 1,648 in October 2001, a rise of +17.6%.
  - (c) The number of employee jobs recorded in respect of the private sector increased by +6.2%, from 9,509 in October 2000 to 10,099 in October 2001, with the number of jobs in the Financial Intermediation industry increasing over the period from 1,106 to 1,183 (+7.0%). However, the number of employee jobs in the other Services industry decreased by 179 (-16.3%) over the period reflecting the reduced presence, in employment terms, of the gambling firms.
  - (d) During the period, the total number of weekly-paid full-time adult employee jobs rose from 4,367 in October 2000 to 4,768 in October 2001 (+9.2%). Monthly-paid full-time adult employee jobs from increased from 6,843 to 6,945 (+1.5%) over the same period. Thus, the total number of adult full-time employee jobs increased from 11,210 in October 2000 to 11,713 in October 2001 (+4.5%).
  - (e) Average weekly earnings in respect of full-time adult male employee jobs increased from £258.39 in October 2000 to £284.49 in October 2001 (+10.1%), with earnings in the Private Sector increasing by +7.6%. The number of full-time weekly-paid adult male jobs rose from 3,276 to 3,606 (+10.1%) with jobs in the Construction industry increasing by +26.6% from 1,039 to 1,315.
  - (f) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid full-time adult male jobs increased by +7.1%, from £1,892.56 to £2,027.50 over the period. The earnings of monthly-paid full-time female jobs increased by +4.8%, from £1,361.63 to £1,427.46. The number of full-time monthly-paid adult jobs recorded in the Other Services Industry group decreased by -8.8% in respect of males and by -27.3% in respect of females as a result of decreasing employment within the gambling firms.

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## DEFINITIONS AND NOTES

- (1) Official Sector: Gibraltar Government and Ministry of Defence employee jobs.
- (2) Frontier Worker: an employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (3) Juvenile: a person under 18 years of age.
- (4) Part-Time: generally left to the discretion of the employer.
- (5) Industries have been classified according to the UK Standard Industrial Classification 1992, SIC (92).
- (6) Occupations have been classified according to the UK Standard Occupational Classification 2000, SOC (2000).
