Take or send this form to the Nationality and Passport section of the Civil Status and Registration Office, Joshua Hassan House, 3 Secretary's Lane, Gibraltar, with your current passport the prescribed fee, two photographs and any documents required as shown in the guidance notes at least 10 working days before the passport is actually required. You may be allowed to retain your current passport whilst the application is being processed, but it must be presented for cancellation on collection of the new passport.

Please note that British passports may be issued in Gibraltar only to British Citizens and British Overseas Territories Citizens.

We may check information about you with other information we have. We may get information about you from other people and certain other organisations. We may give information to certain other organisations, as the law allows, to:

- check the accuracy of information;
- prevent or detect crime;
- protect public funds in other ways; and
- · use in research or statistics.

These other organisations include other government departments, local authorities, and private sector bodies such as banks and organisations that may lend you money. We will not give information about you to anyone outside our department unless the law allows us to.
