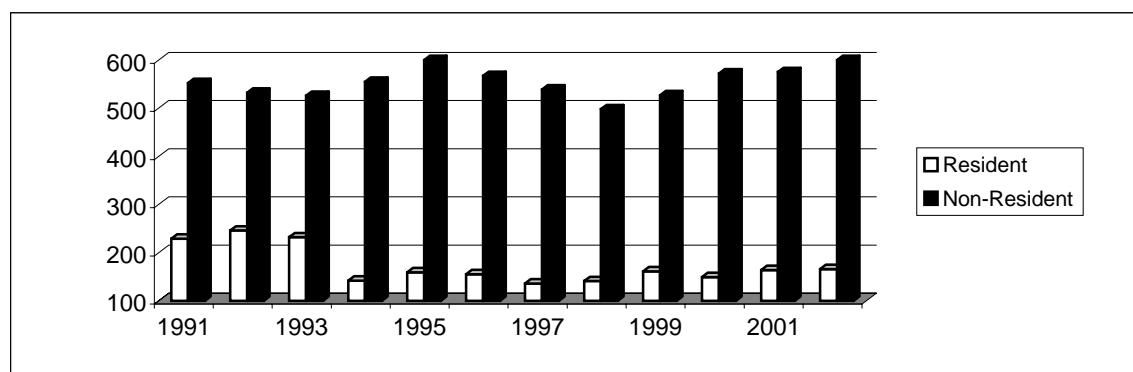

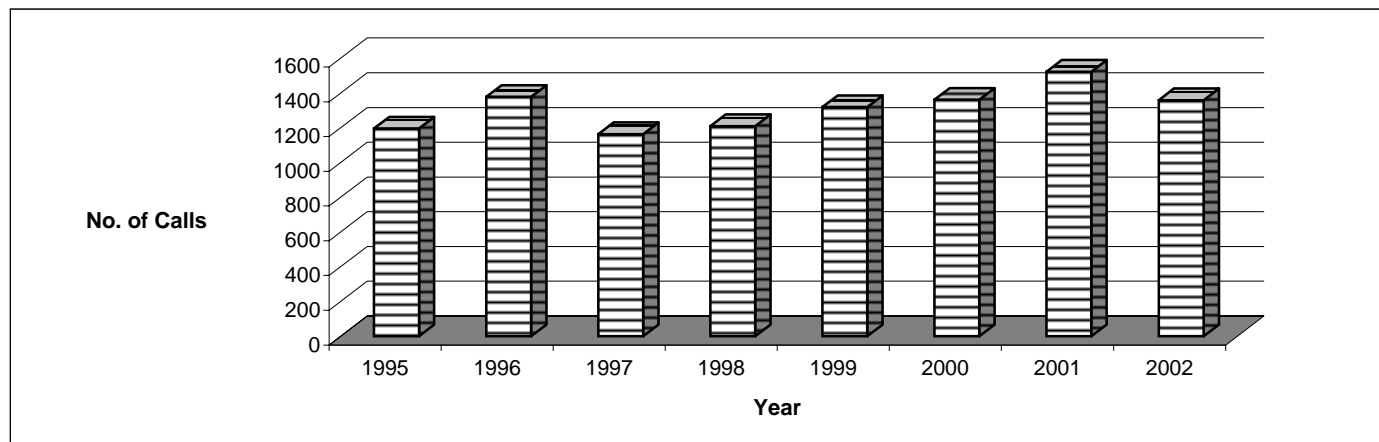

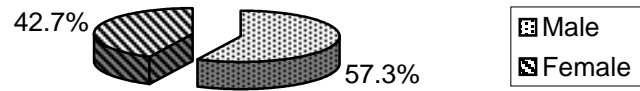

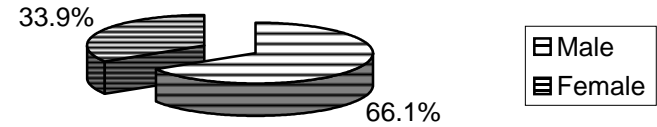

Weekly-Paid and Monthly-Paid Employee Jobs by Sex

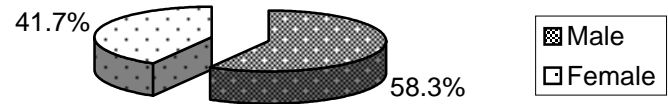
Official Sector Weekly-Paid Employee Jobs

Private Sector Monthly-Paid Employee Jobs

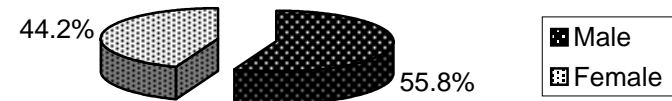

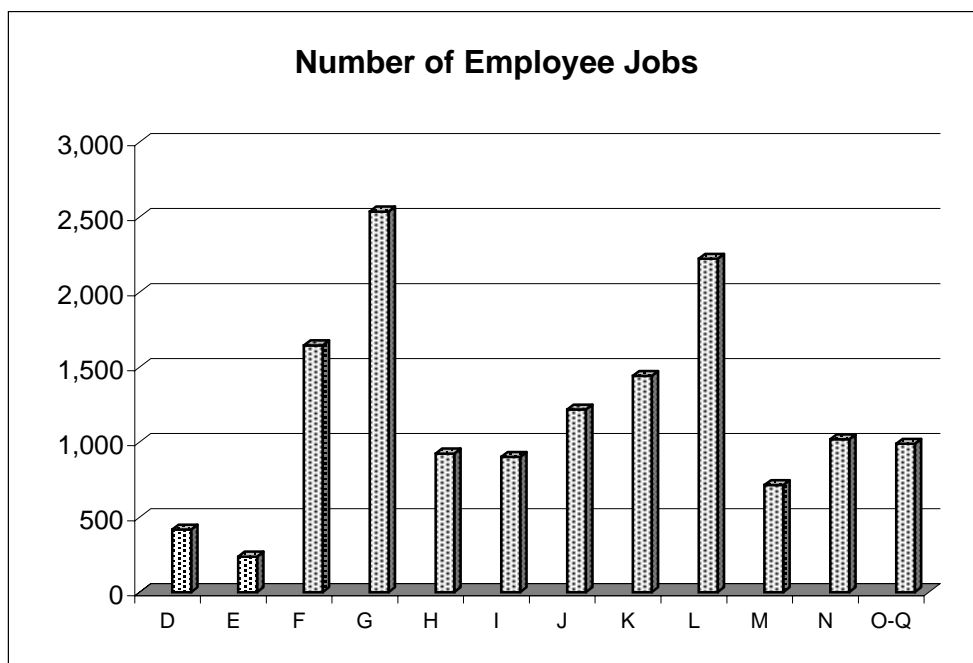

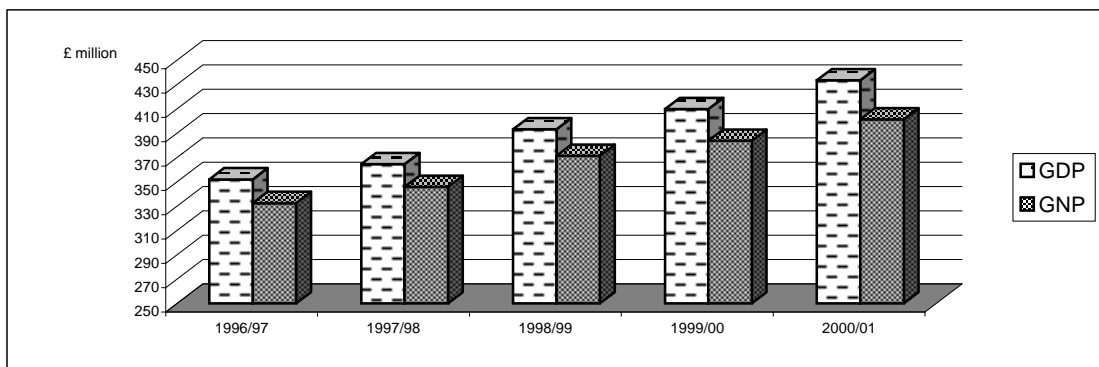

This progressively created a situation where there was insufficient quantitative and qualitative data about the contribution of this expanding private sector activity in the economy. Consequently, the residual errors in the National Income estimates were growing significantly from year to year throughout the 1990's and when the 1996/97 National Income estimates were being calculated, the residual error was too large for the estimates to be treated with any acceptable degree of confidence and reliability. Outside specialist advice was engaged which confirmed that the National Income estimates were weakly based and unreliable. An Input/Output Study was commissioned in 1999 which, inter alia, would provide a sound basis for verification of the National Income figures. The Study suffered delays for reasons outside the control of the Gibraltar Government and provisional results became available in May 2002.
- (2) The Input/Output Study estimate of GDP for 1999/00 was £411.0 million. The GDP figure, using the traditional income method, for that year was estimated at £409.89m. The closeness of the estimates indicates that a significant degree of confidence and reliability can now be placed on the GNP/GDP figures. The calculation of GDP estimates from 1996/97 onwards have now been resumed.

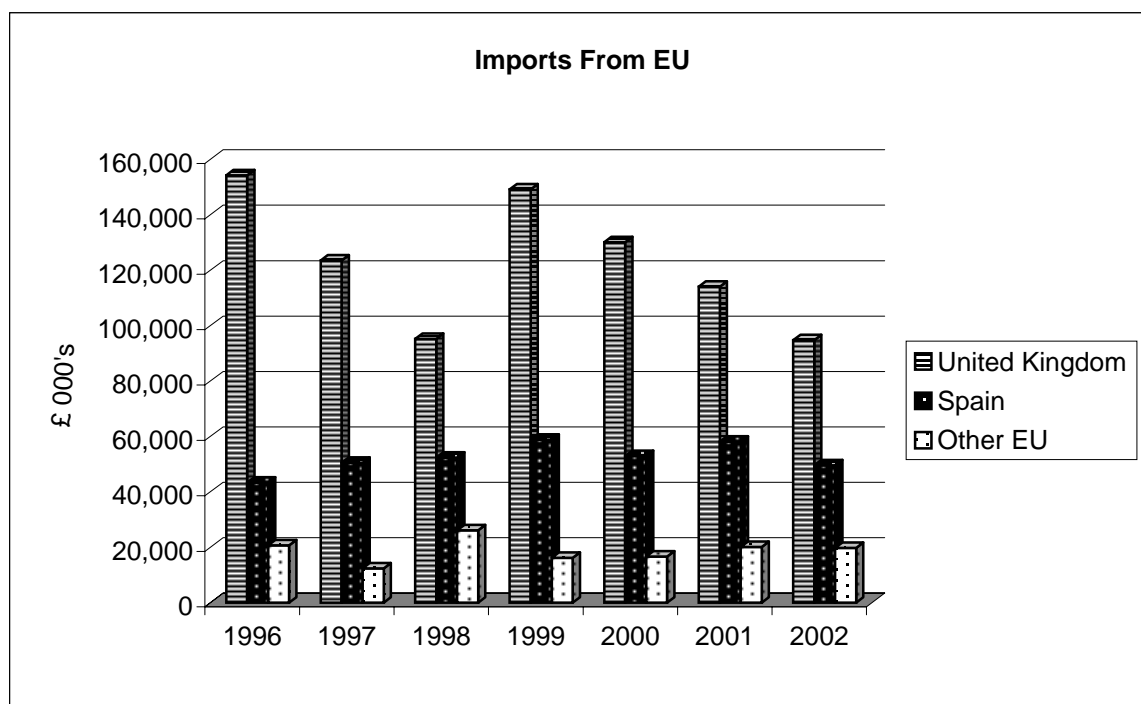

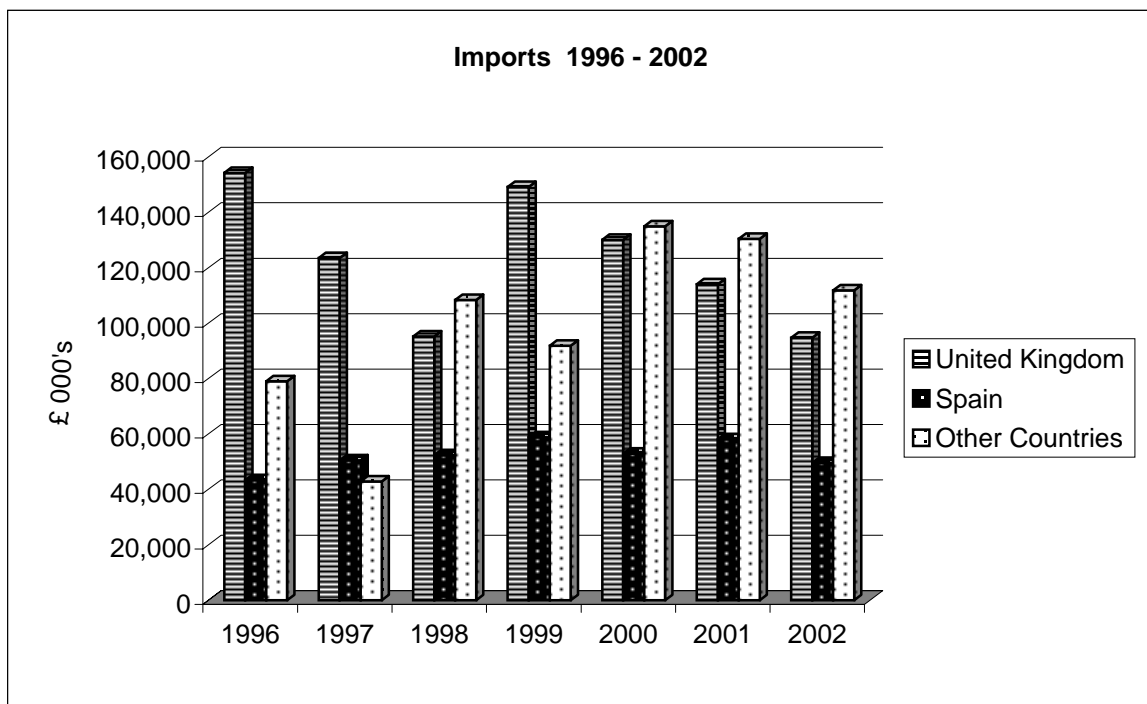

VISITOR ARRIVALS, 1981 - 2002

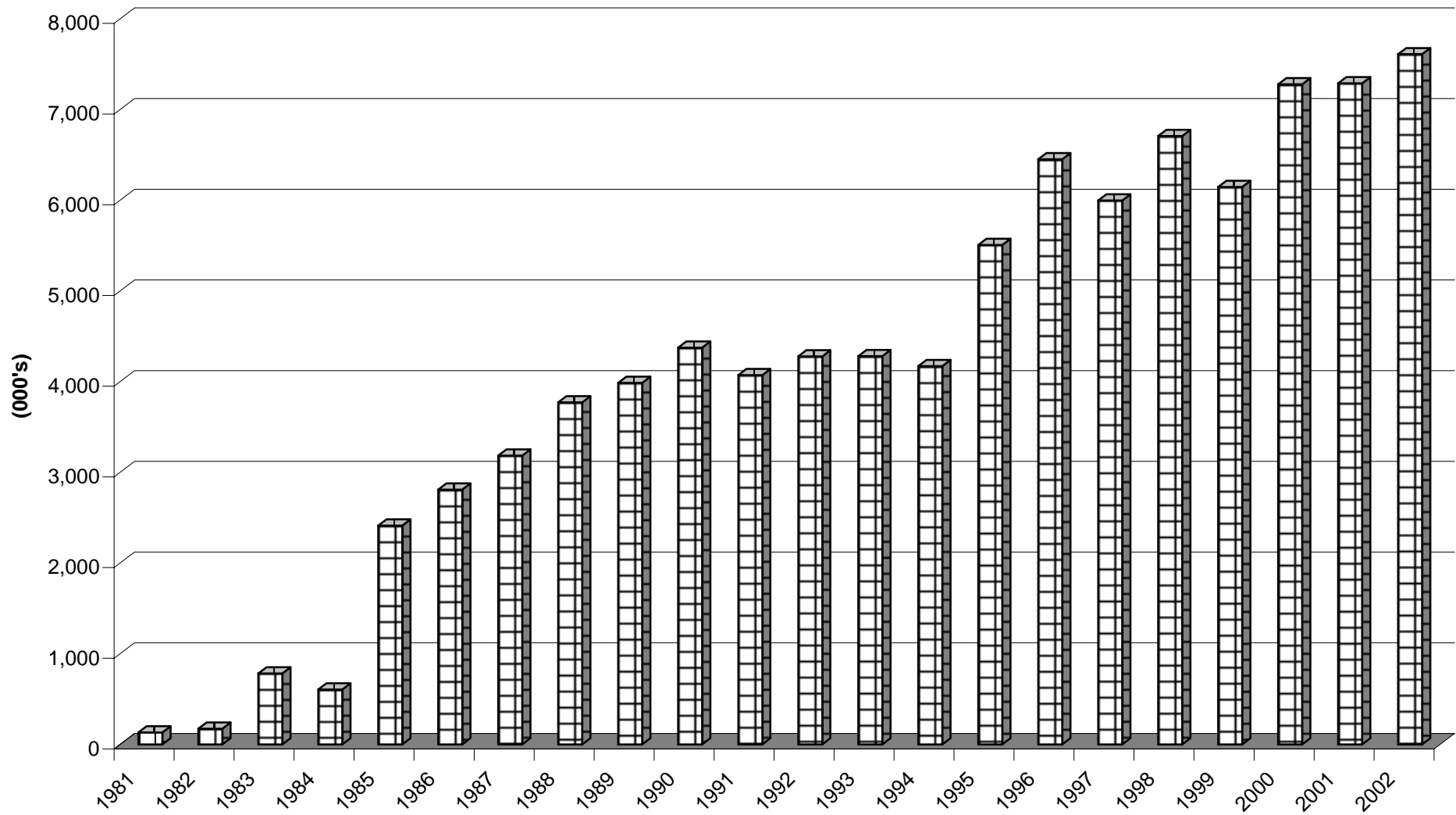

ARRIVALS BY AIR FROM UK, 1978 - 2002

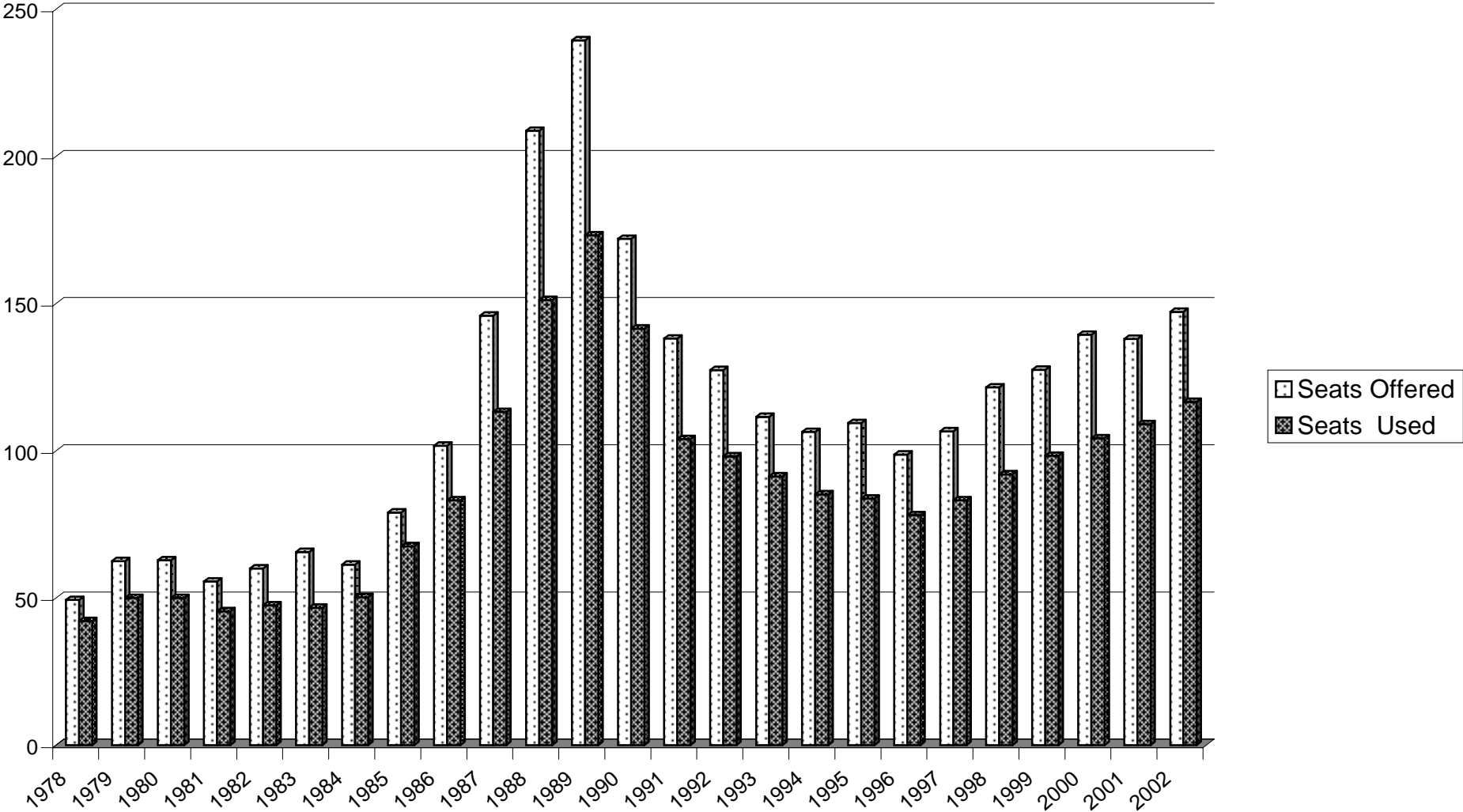
