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PREFACE

The Statistics Act (Employment Survey Order as Amended) 1970 requires that the Government Statistician prepare a report for Parliament, the purpose of which is to obtain information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar.

In October 2009, all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. Three reminders were sent to late respondents with the survey closing in February 2010. The response rate was almost 100% with only 39 employers out of the 2,007 who had been sent the survey form failing to complete and return the questionnaire or register a nil return.

I must express my thanks to all employers for their continued co-operation in the conduct of this survey.

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SURVEY SUMMARY

1. The number of employee jobs reported in October 2009 decreased by - 0.3% (-59) from 20,509 in October 2008 to 20,450. However, this still represented the second highest number of employee jobs ever recorded. The response rate continued at almost 100% with 1,342 out of the 2,007 known employers completing the questionnaire in respect of their employees and 626 registering a nil return.
2. The main employment trends during the period covered by this report can be summarised as follows:
 - (a) Average annual earnings in respect of all employee jobs increased by +3.0%, from £22,266.30 in October 2008 to £22,928.25 in October 2009.
 - (b) The largest increase in the level of employee jobs by industry was that registered in the Gambling and Betting Activities sub-industry within the Other Services industry. The number of jobs recorded in this sub-industry increased by +180 (+9.2%), from 1,952 in October 2008 to 2,132 in October 2009. However, the number of employee jobs in the Construction industry fell by -356 (-12.2%) over the period, with jobs in the Financial Intermediation industry also falling by -80 (- 4.1%). As a consequence, employment in the private sector decreased by -1.5%, from 15,450 in October 2008 to 15,213 in October 2009.
 - (c) The number of employee jobs in the Public Sector increased by +215 (+5.0%) mainly as a result of Gibraltar General Construction Company Ltd employing 153 former workers of other construction firms.
 - (d) Gibraltar Community Care Ltd recorded an increase of +196 community officers compared with October 2008. This increase is reflected in the number of part-time employee jobs shown under the Real Estate and Business Activities industry.
 - (e) Employment in the Ministry of Defence fell from 773 in October 2008 to 736 in October 2009, a decrease of -37 (-4.8%).
 - (f) Employers were asked to identify detached workers in their survey returns. A total of 79 such workers in the private sector were recorded as follows:

- (g) During the period, the total number of weekly-paid full-time adult employee jobs decreased from 5,064 in October 2008 to 4,652 in October 2009 (-8.1%). Monthly-paid full-time adult employee jobs increased from 12,239 to 12,302 (+0.5%) over the same period. Thus, the total number of adult full-time employee jobs decreased from 17,303 in October 2008 to 16,954 in October 2009 (-2.0%).

- (h) Average weekly earnings in respect of full-time adult male employee jobs decreased marginally from £379.16 in October 2008 to £377.72 in October 2009 (-0.4%). The number of full-time weekly-paid adult male jobs fell from 3,741 to 3,404 (-9.0%) with jobs in the Construction and the Real Estate and Business Activities industries falling by -111 and -176 respectively. Average weekly earnings of full-time adult female employee jobs increased from £233.14 to £252.86 (+8.5%) over the period. The number of full-time weekly-paid adult female jobs decreased by -5.7% from 1,323 to 1,248 with jobs in the Hotels and Restaurants and the Real Estate and Business Activities industries decreasing by -14.4% and - 4.7% respectively.
- (i) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid full-time adult male jobs increased by +4.6%, from £2,636.52 to £2,757.66 over the period. The earnings of full-time monthly-paid female jobs increased by +4.8%, from £1,922.60 to £2,014.73. The number of full-time monthly-paid adult male jobs decreased by -0.6%, from 7,426 to 7,378, with jobs in the Construction industry decreasing by -18.1%. The number of full-time monthly-paid adult female jobs increased by +2.3%, from 4,813 to 4,924 with jobs in the Other Services and Health and Social Work industries increasing by +5.1% and +4.5% respectively.

DEFINITIONS AND NOTES

- (1) Frontier Worker: an employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (2) Detached Worker: A detached worker is defined as any person, who is not ordinarily resident in Gibraltar and is in employment in a country outside Gibraltar and who is required by his employer to perform work of a temporary nature in Gibraltar in the course of his employment.
- (3) Juvenile: a person under 18 years of age.
- (4) Part-Time: generally left to the discretion of the employer.
- (5) Industries have been classified according to the UK Standard Industrial Classification 1992, SIC (92).
- (6) Occupations have been classified according to the UK Standard Occupational Classification 2000, SOC (2000).
- (7) Public Sector: all Government Departments, statutory authorities and agencies financed by the Gibraltar Government and wholly-owned Government companies.
