## PREFACE

The Statistics Ordinance (Employment Survey Order as Amended) 1970 requires that the Government Statistician prepare a report for the House of Assembly. This is the fifty-fifth such survey the purpose of which is to obtain information regarding trends in employment, hours worked and earnings of all employees in Gibraltar.

In October 2005, all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. Three reminders were sent to late respondents with the survey closing in March 2006. The response rate was excellent with only 20 employers out of the 1,426 who had been sent the survey form failing to complete and return the questionnaire or register a nil return.

I must express my thanks to all employers for their continued co-operation in the conduct of this survey.

## SURVEY SUMMARY

1. The number of employee jobs recorded in October 2005 increased by +5.5% from 15,994 in October 2004 to 16,874. This represents the highest number ever covered by the Employment Survey. The response rate was almost complete with 1,080 out of the 1,426 known employers returning completed questionnaires and 326 registering a nil return.
2. The main employment trends during the period covered by the report can be summarised as follows:
  - (a) Average annual earnings in respect of all employee jobs increased by +8.7%, from £17,834.25 in October 2004 to £19,383.80 in October 2005.
  - (b) The largest increase in the level of employee jobs by industry were those registered in the Other Services industry. The number of jobs recorded for this industry increased by 379 (+22.8%) between October 2004 and October 2005.
  - (c) The number of employee jobs recorded in respect of the private sector increased by +6.5%, from 12,030 in October 2004 to 12,812 in October 2005. The number of jobs in the Gambling & Betting Activities sub-industry increased significantly over the period from 1,124 to 1,495 (+33.0%).
  - (d) The total number of weekly-paid full-time adult employee jobs fell marginally from 4,506 in October 2004 to 4,440 in October 2005 (-1.5%). Monthly-paid full-time adult employee jobs increased from 8,950 to 9,744 (+8.9%) over the same period. Thus, the total number of adult full-time employee jobs increased from 13,456 in October 2004 to 14,184 in October 2005 (+5.4%).
  - (e) Average weekly earnings in respect of full-time adult male employee jobs increased from £292.56 in October 2004 to £316.41 in October 2005 (+8.2%). The number of full-time weekly-paid adult male jobs fell from 3,362 to 3,297 (-1.9%) with jobs in the Transport and Communication and Hotels and Restaurants industries increasing by +11.5% and +7.4% respectively.
  - (f) Earnings in respect of monthly-paid full-time adult male jobs increased by +8.2%, from £2,211.53 to £2,393.16 over the period. The earnings of full-time monthly-paid female jobs increased by +4.3%, from £1,586.88 to £1,655.60. The number of full-time monthly-paid adult jobs recorded in the Other Services industry group increased by +38.5% in respect of males and by +24.6% in respect of females mainly as a result of increased employment within the gambling firms.
  - (g) Employee jobs in respect of the dinner ladies employed at Government schools have been reclassified under the Elementary Occupation group. Previously, they were included under Personal Service group.

- (h) The number of employee jobs shown under the Education Industry has increased by 60 between October 2004 and October 2005. This is the result of the inclusion of persons directly employed by the Education Department on a supply basis which have not formed part of the Treasury payroll and have consequently been excluded from previous Employment Surveys.

## DEFINITIONS AND NOTES

- (1) Official Sector: Gibraltar Government and Ministry of Defence employee jobs.
- (2) Frontier Worker: an employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (3) Juvenile: a person under 18 years of age.
- (4) Part-Time: generally left to the discretion of the employer.
- (5) Industries have been classified according to the UK Standard Industrial Classification 1992, SIC (92).
- (6) Occupations have been classified according to the UK Standard Occupational Classification 2000, SOC (2000).
