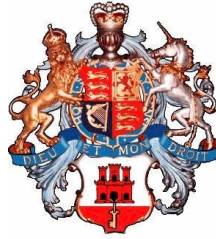

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PREFACE

The Statistics (Employment Survey) Order 1971 requires that the Government Statistician prepare a report and summary of the findings of the Employment Survey to be laid before the Gibraltar Parliament.

In October 2012, all known employers were sent Employment Survey questionnaires in respect of their employees. Three reminders were sent to late respondents with the survey closing in March 2013. The response rate was almost 100% with 1,374 out of the 2,139 known employers completing the questionnaire in respect of their employees and 719 registering a nil return.

I must express my thanks to all employers for their continued co-operation in the conduct of this survey.

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SURVEY SUMMARY

Employee Jobs October 2012

- In October 2012 the number of employee jobs was 21,519, representing a decrease of 3.3% (-728) compared with October 2011.
- The fall in employee jobs was driven by the decline in the Construction industry within the Private Sector, that decreased by 1,403 (-48.0%), from 2,922 jobs in October 2011 to 1,519 in October 2012. Despite of this decrease, jobs in the service-providing industries within the Private sector continued to grow. The greatest increase came from the Other Services industry that grew by 194 (+5.7%), from 3,392 to 3,586 over the period. The largest job gains within this industry was that registered in the Gambling and Betting Activities sub-industry, where jobs grew to a record 2,848, up 5.0% (+136) from October 2011. Other service-providing industries including: Wholesale and Retail 79 (+2.6%), Hotels and Restaurants 38 (+3.2%) and Financial Intermediation 29 (+1.5%) also produced job gains over the period.
- The number of jobs in the Public sector increased by 417 (+9.1%), from 4,574 to 4,991 between October 2011 and October 2012. The largest job increase over the year was registered in the Public Administration and Defence industry that grew by 162 (+13.9%), led by gains of 140 jobs in the General Public Services Activities sub-industry. An increase of 106 jobs was recorded in the Security and Related Activities sub-industry within the Real Estate and Business Activities industry and 97 jobs were created in the Health and Social Work industry over the year. The only industry that registered a decrease in jobs compared with October 2011, was the Construction industry that lost 23 jobs. The MoD decreased by 4.1% (-29) compared with October 2011.

Full-time employee jobs

- Full-time adult employee jobs decreased by 3.8% (-719) from 19,015 in October 2011 to 18,296 in October 2012.
- Monthly-paid full-time adult employee jobs decreased by 1.9% from 14,238 in October 2011 to 13,974 in October 2012. Monthly-paid full-time adult male jobs fell by 649 (-7.2%), from 8,973 to 8,324. Job losses were concentrated in the Construction industry, which decreased by 1,062 (-56.9%) in the year to year comparison. Monthly-paid full-time adult female jobs grew by 7.3% (+385) from 5,265 to 5,650, with jobs in the Health and Social Work, Public Administration and Defence and Other Services rising by 104 (+11.4%), 84 (+15.4%) and 70 (+7.3%) respectively, over the year.
- Weekly-paid full-time adult employee jobs decreased by 9.5% from 4,777 to 4,322 over the period. Weekly-paid full-time adult male jobs fell by 12.5% from 3,521 to 3,080, with the largest decrease registered in the Construction industry that fell by 26.4% (-354). There were pockets of growth in the Hotels and Restaurants, Other Services and Wholesale and Retail industries, which increased by 14.7%, 5.3% and 2.1% respectively. Weekly-paid full-time adult female jobs fell marginally by 1.1% from 1,256 to 1,242, with jobs in the Real Estate and Business Activities and Wholesale and Retail Trade industries falling by 6.0% and 3.1% respectively. These decreases were offset by job gains in the Hotels and Restaurants industry of 27 (+10.5%), over the year.

Part-time employee jobs

- Part-time adult employee jobs fell marginally by 0.3% from 3,155 in October 2011 to 3,146 in October 2012.
- Monthly-paid part-time adult employee jobs fell slightly by 0.2% from 1,726 to 1,722 over the period. There was job growth by 6.5% of monthly-paid part-time adult male employees, with gains in Public Administration and Defence (+18), Other Services (+12) and Hotels and Restaurants (+11) compared to October 2011. The number of monthly-paid part-time adult female jobs decreased by 1.7% from 1,416 to 1,392, with the largest job losses in Health and Social Work, down by 19.0% (-38) over the period.
- Weekly-paid part-time adult employee jobs fell marginally by 0.3% from 1,429 to 1,424 compared to October 2011. Weekly-paid part-time adult male jobs decreased by 3.9% from 383 to 368, with jobs in the Construction and Hotels and Restaurants industries dropping by 20 and 10 respectively. This was offset by a marginal increase in the Transport and Communication industry, up by 10 jobs over the year. Weekly-paid part-time adult female jobs increased slightly by 1.0% from 1,046 to 1,056, with jobs in the Health and Social Work and Wholesale and Retail Trade industries growing by 21 and 10 respectively over the year. This increase was offset by a decrease of 25 jobs in the Hotels and Restaurants industry over the period.

Detached workers

- Employers were asked to identify detached workers in their survey returns. A total of 65 such workers in the private sector were recorded as follows:

Average Earnings October 2012

- Average gross annual earnings in respect of all employee jobs increased by 3.5%, from £25,831.19 in October 2011 to £26,747.34 in October 2012.

Full-time average earnings

- Average gross annual earnings for full-time employees were up 3.7% from £28,484.51 in October 2011 to £29,539.79 in October 2012.
- Average gross annual earnings for monthly-paid full-time male employees grew by 5.7% from £34,838.74 in October 2011 to £36,837.56 in October 2012.

- Average gross annual earnings for monthly-paid full-time female employees increased by 1.7% from £26,338.43 in October 2011 to £26,778.09 in October 2012.
- Average gross earnings in respect of monthly-paid full-time adult male employees increased by 5.8%, from £2,911.71 in October 2011 to £3,079.59 in October 2012. The average gross earnings of full-time monthly-paid adult female employees increased by 1.6%, from £2,200.93 to £2,235.79 over the period.
- Average gross annual earnings for weekly-paid full-time male employees fell by 0.9% from £21,001.20 in October 2011 to £20,815.95 in October 2012.
- Average gross annual earnings for weekly-paid full-time female employees increased by 6.3% from £13,572.21 in October 2011 to £14,424.05 in October 2012.
- Average gross weekly earnings in respect of full-time adult male employees decreased by 0.9% from £404.07 in October 2011 to £400.46 in October 2012. Average gross weekly earnings of full-time adult female employees increased by 6.3% from £261.07 to £277.39 over the period.

Part-time average earnings

- Average gross annual earnings for part-time employees were up 2.9% from £9,924.83 in October 2011 to £10,207.95 in October 2012.
- Average gross annual earnings for monthly-paid part-time male employees grew by 6.5% from £12,993.95 in October 2011 to £13,834.84 in October 2012.
- Average gross annual earnings for monthly-paid part-time female employees decreased by 2.2% from £12,499.14 in October 2011 to £12,223.72 in October 2012.
- Average gross earnings in respect of monthly-paid part-time adult male employees increased by 6.3% from £1,084.45 in October 2011 to £1,153.26 in October 2012. The average gross earnings of part-time monthly-paid adult female employees decreased by 2.5%, from £1,045.29 to £1,019.57 over the period.
- Average gross annual earnings for weekly-paid part-time male employees increased by 28.8% from £6,423.24 in October 2011 to £8,276.06 in October 2012.
- Average gross annual earnings for weekly-paid part-time female employees increased by 5.8% from £6,818.15 in October 2011 to £7,211.48 in October 2012.
- Average gross weekly earnings in respect of part-time adult male employees increased by 28.9% from £124.30 to £160.24 over the period. Average gross weekly earnings of part-time adult female employees increased by 5.7% from £131.32 to £138.80 over the period.

DEFINITIONS

- (a) Frontier Worker: an employee who is normally resident in Spain and is employed in Gibraltar.
- (b) Detached Worker: a detached worker is defined as any person who is not ordinarily resident in Gibraltar, is in employment in a country outside Gibraltar and who is required by his employer to perform work of a temporary nature in Gibraltar during the course of his employment.
- (c) Juvenile: a person under 18 years of age.
- (d) Part-Time: generally left to the discretion of the employer.
- (e) Public Sector: all Government Departments, statutory authorities and agencies financed by the Gibraltar Government and wholly-owned Government companies.

- (b) Occupations have been classified according to the UK Standard Occupational Classification 2000, SOC (2000).

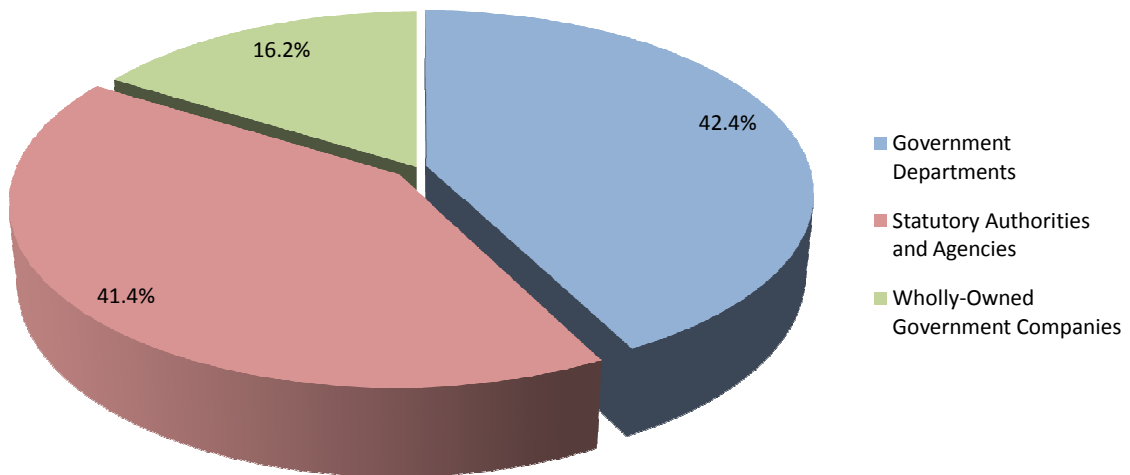

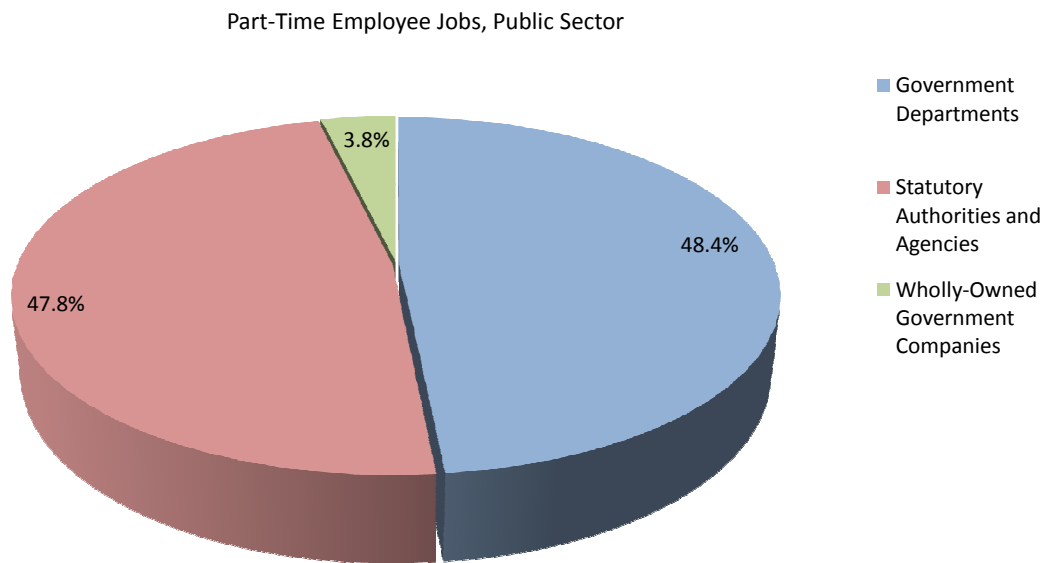

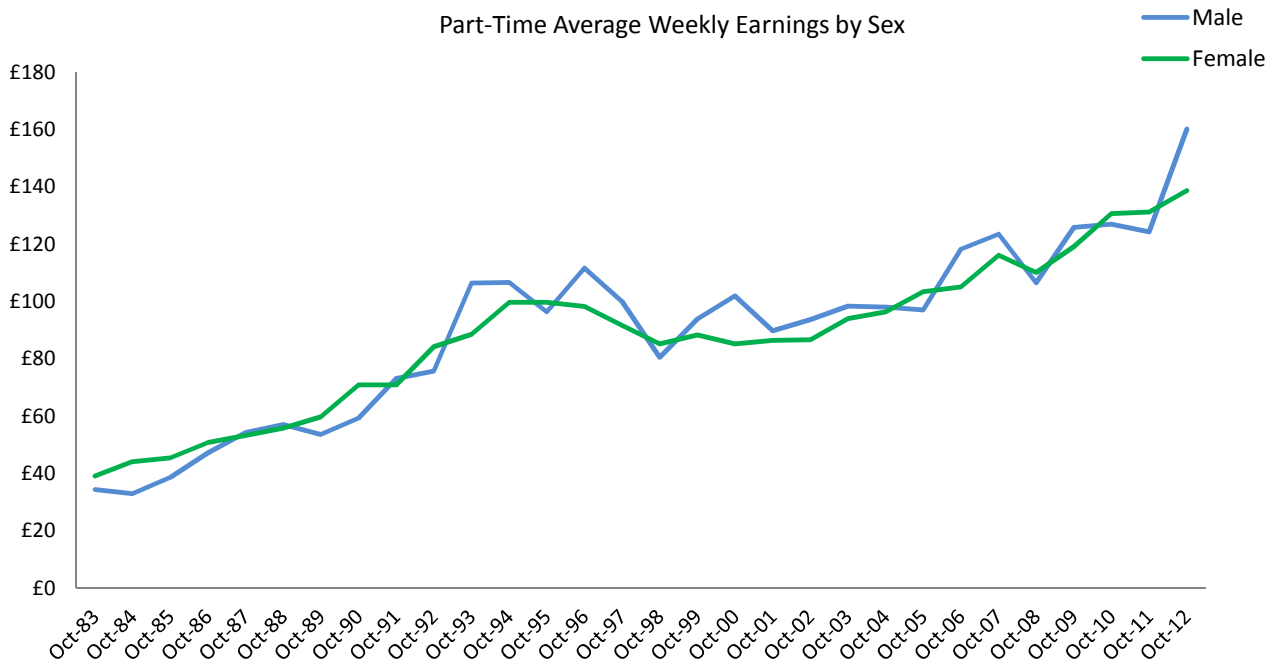

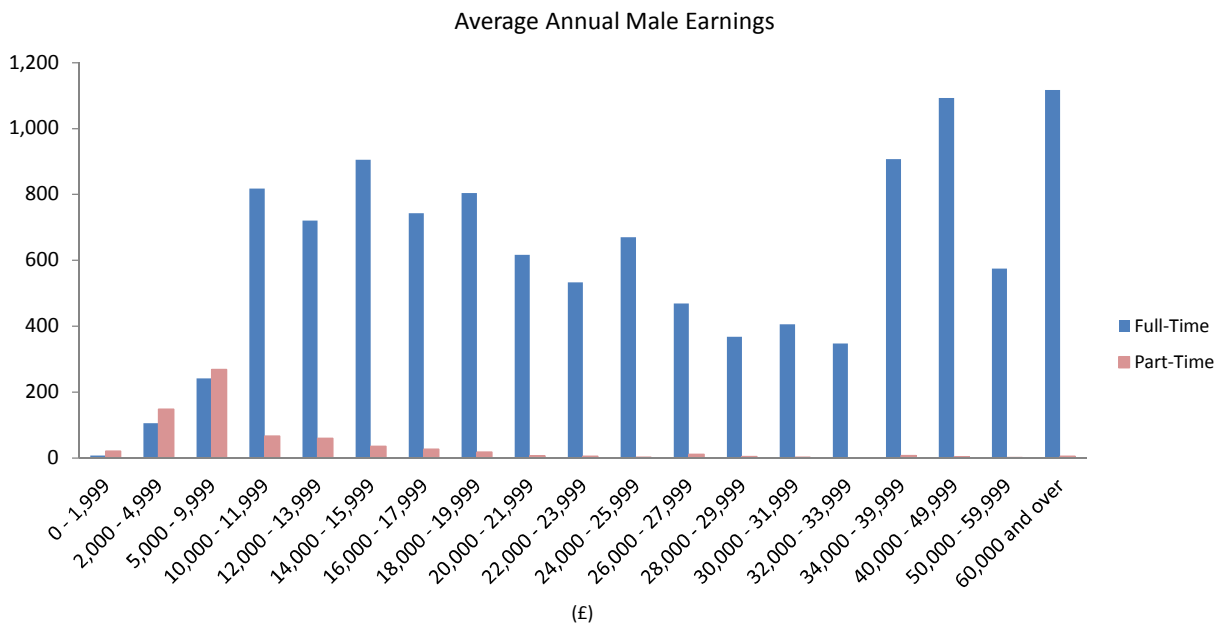

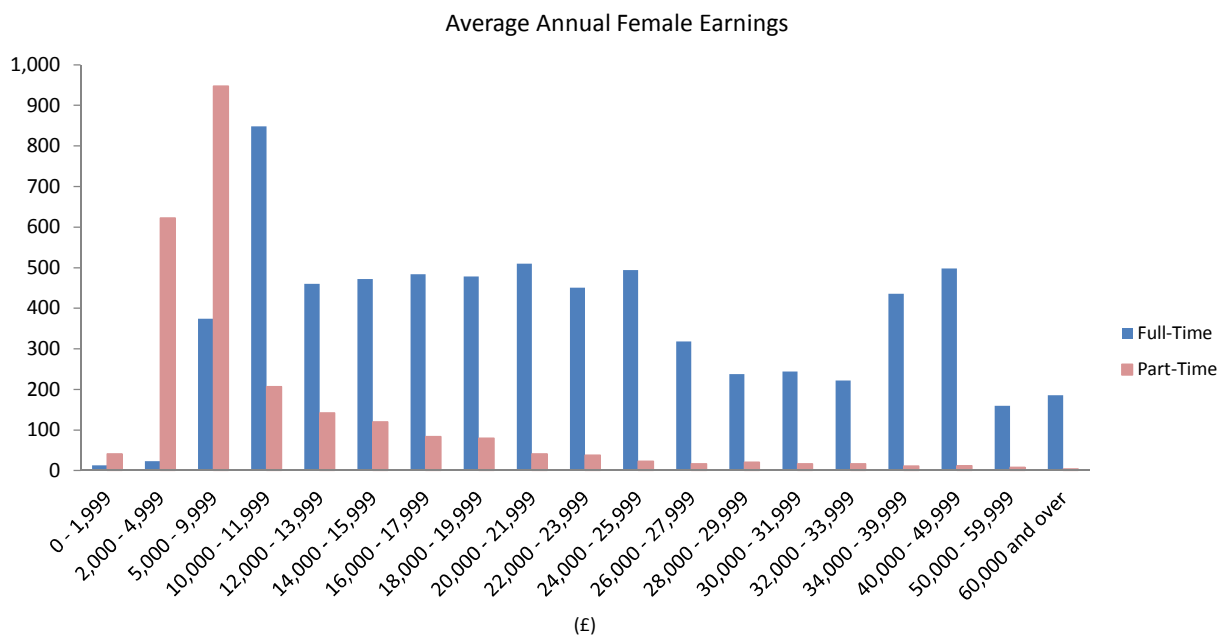

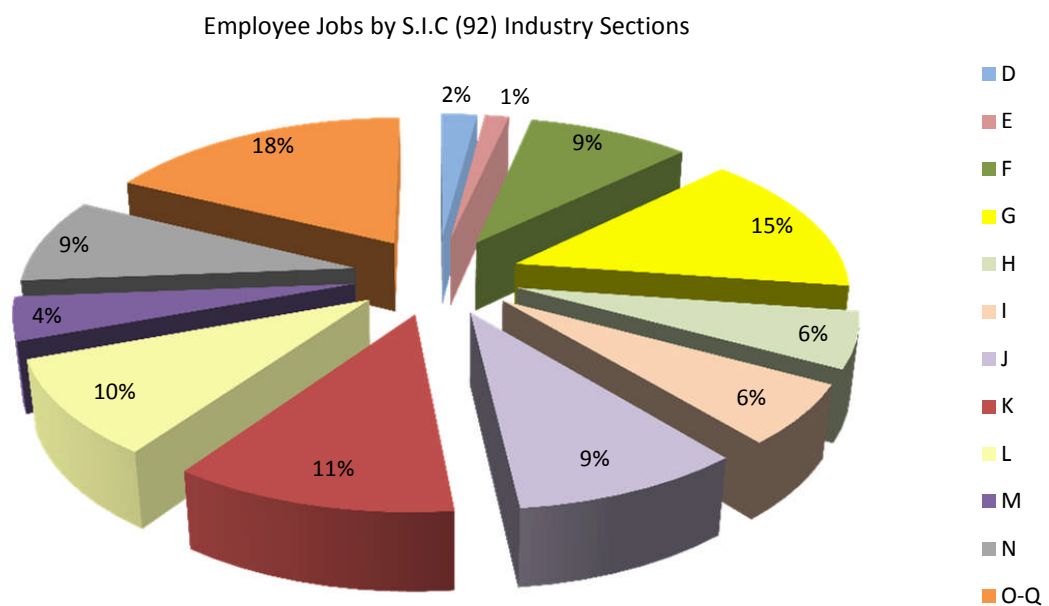
