MECHANICAL GRADE – TECHNICAL (D7) ELECTRICAL GRADE – TECHNICAL (D7) and SKILLED (D8)

Applications are invited from persons who by virtue of their citizenship are entitled to take up employment and who are, or on employment will be, resident in Gibraltar, for the following posts in the Gibraltar Electricity Authority.

One – Technical Grade D7 Mechanical (Technomedical Division)

Applicants must have completed an approved indentured Apprenticeship in a relevant mechanical discipline, or alternatively, have attained equivalent or higher qualifications in the relevant field of Mechanical Engineering.

The employee would be deployed within the facilities of the Gibraltar Health Authority and duties include install, maintain and repair mechanical and allied systems.

One – Technical Grade D7 Electrical (Technomedical Division)

Applicants must have completed an approved indentured Apprenticeship in a relevant electrical/electronic discipline, or alternatively, have attained equivalent or higher qualifications in the relevant field of Electrical / Electronic Engineering.

The employee would be deployed within the facilities of the Gibraltar Health Authority and duties include install, maintain and repair electrical and electronic plant, clinical equipment and allied systems.

Two – Skilled Grade D8 Electrical (Distribution Network Division)

Applicants must have basic knowledge of electricity and must submit documentary evidence or suitable references stating that they have undertaken, or assisted with, electrical works or electrical equipment and products and have been actively engaged in such duties for a period of not less than three years.

These employees would be deployed to assist technical grades in all duties covered by the distribution network division, which include excavations.

General Terms

Salary scales based on a 37 hour 5 day week are as follows:-

Grade D7 - £21, 792 to £25,498

Grade D8 - £20,267 to £23,715

Entry is at the minimum point of a 5 point scale. Annual progression is subject to satisfactory performance. The successful applicant will be engaged on a six months probationary period.

An employee joining the Authority will be eligible to participate in the Gibraltar Provident Trust no.2 pension scheme subject to the person engaged contributing 5% of basic salary.
