VACANCY FOR MARINE SURVEYOR

The Government of Gibraltar invites applications for appointment as Marine Surveyor with the Gibraltar Maritime Administration. Applicants must by virtue of their citizenship, be entitled to take up employment in Gibraltar.

The successful applicant will be required to travel, when necessary, in order to conduct surveys, inspections and audits of Gibraltar ships or to conduct inquiries into any accident or casualties on Gibraltar ships. Other duties will include PSC inspection of foreign ships in the port of Gibraltar under the Paris MOU, survey of harbour craft, examination of seafarers for competency certificates and approval of service centres for life rafts or training centres for seafarers.

Applicants must possess one or more of the following: -

- a) A valid STCW 95 regulation II/2 certificate of competency for the capacity of 'Master' with at least 3 years post certificate sea-service or shore-based experience.
- b) A valid STCW 95 regulation III/2 certificate of competency for the capacity of 'Chief Engineer' with at least 3 years post certificate sea service or shore based experience.
- c) A degree in 'Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering' with at least 3 years experience in a shipyard or large marine workshops. Must have experience of plan approval to SOLAS, MARPOL and ILO standards.

Preference will be given to applicants qualified to ISM lead auditor and /or having previously worked with a Flag Administration or Classification Society (involvement in enforcement of regulatory measures).

The appointment is on contract terms, initially for three-years. Further particulars of the post may be obtained from the Maritime Administrator on Tel +350 46862.
