Vacancies are open to British Citizens who have been resident in Gibraltar for at least three years, or the spouse of a British Citizen by virtue of a connection with Gibraltar, provided they are resident in Gibraltar, who meets the nationality requirements stated herein, provided they are resident in Gibraltar, or will be so resident, if employed. The minimum academic qualifications required are 5 GCSE (or GCE 'O' Level) passes at A, B or C, or 5 CSE Grade 1, or 5 CEE Grade 1,2 or 3, two of which must be English and Mathematics, or a full GNVQ (Intermediate), BTEC (Intermediate) or BTEC First Diploma together with two GCSE (or GCE 'O' Level) passes at A, B or C in English and Mathematics or 2 CSE Grade 1 in English and Mathematics, or 2 CEE passes at Grades 1,2 or 3 in English and Mathematics.

However, if you do not have these qualifications you may still be considered for appointment if you successfully undertake an entry examination.

The posts are permanent and pensionable and the basic salary scale ranges from £20,888 to £32,796 per annum.
