Applications are invited for the post of Statistics Officer Level 1 in the Statistics Office. Applicants must, by virtue of their citizenship, be entitled to take up employment in Gibraltar and on taking up appointment they must be resident in Gibraltar.

2. Applicants must possess either: -

- i. A degree in statistics or mathematics or equivalent qualification or higher; or
- ii. A degree in economics or business studies or equivalent, or higher qualification.

3. Basic competence in the use of Microsoft Word, Excel and Access is also a requirement. It is essential for the applicant to be fluent in both spoken and written English.

4. The successful applicant for the post will be required, unless he/she already satisfies the qualification criteria as specified in 2i, to undertake the necessary training to achieve the Ordinary Certificate of the Royal Statistics Society within a maximum of two years.

5. The post is on contract terms, initially for one year if the candidate possesses the required qualification, or two years if the candidate requires undertaking the necessary training to achieve the qualification. Further employment in the post will be subject to satisfactory performance. The salary scale ranges from £19,975 to £27,530 per annum.
