TRAINING COURSES IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE

The Government of Gibraltar together with the Gibraltar Health Authority invites applications from persons aged between 16 and 25 years of age and are ordinarily resident in Gibraltar, to undertake National Vocational Training in **Health and Social Care**.

Trainees will follow an accredited training programme during a period of approximately two years, set by Edexcel an official UK Awarding Body, leading to the attainment of National Vocational Qualifications, at level 2 in Health and Social Care.

All applicants will be required to sit entry level examinations in Numeracy and Literacy and if successful at these will be invited for interview.

The Government of Gibraltar is fully committed to equal opportunities and therefore, encourages applications from males and females alike. Trainees successfully selected to participate in the Health and Social Care Training Scheme will be entitled to receive a monthly Trainee's Allowance, commensurate with age.
