



TRAINING COURSES IN CONSTRUCTION TRADES

The Government of Gibraltar invites applications from persons ordinarily resident in Gibraltar to undertake apprenticeships of three year duration in the following trades:

Carpentry & Joinery
Painting & Decorating
Plumbing
Bricklaying
Plastering
Wall & Floor Tiling
Multi-skill option (Bricklaying, Plastering, Wall & Floor Tiling)

Trainees will follow an accredited training programme set by the UK Awarding Body leading to the attainment of Construction Awards and/or National Vocational Qualifications, at levels 1, 2 and 3.

Applicant's not in possession of GCSE passes in English Language and Mathematics at Grades A to D, or equivalents will be required to sit entry level examinations in Numeracy and Literacy.

The Government of Gibraltar is fully committed to equal opportunities and therefore, encourages applications from males and females alike. Trainees successfully selected to participate in the Construction Trades Training Scheme will be entitled to receive a monthly Trainee's Allowance, commensurate with age.

Application Forms are available from the Training Unit at Bleak House Institute of Training, Europa Point, and completed applications must be returned by not later than **9th September 2011**.
