



TRAINING COURSES IN ENGINEERING TRADES

The Government of Gibraltar and Gibdock Limited, invites applications from persons ordinarily resident in Gibraltar to undertake apprenticeships of four years duration in the following trades:

Fabrication and Welding Mechanical Engineering

Trainees will follow an accredited training programme set by the Engineering and Maritime Authority (EMTA) an official UK Awarding Body, leading to the attainment of National Vocational Qualifications, at levels 2 and 3.

Applicant's not in possession of GCSE passes in English Language, Mathematics and a Science Subject at Grades A to D, or equivalents will be required to sit entry level examinations in these subjects.

The Government of Gibraltar is fully committed to equal opportunities and therefore, encourages applications from males and females alike. Trainees successfully selected to participate in the Engineering Trades Training Scheme will be entitled to receive a monthly Trainee's Allowance, commensurate with age.
