Technical Grade D7 – Electrical Fitter/Technician

Applicants must have completed an approved indentured Apprenticeship as electrical fitter and must be qualified electrical fitters with sufficient technical knowledge and experience to undertake high complex work within the electrical discipline. Applicants should preferably have experience in high voltage/low voltage generation and distribution or consumer services.

Applicants should have a BTEC in electrical engineering or similar approved training course or alternatively, have attained equivalent or higher qualifications in the relevant field and be experienced in complex electrical works.

Salary scales based on a 37 hour 5 day week are as follows:-

Grade D7 - £25,669 to £29,912

Entry is at the minimum point of a 5 point scale. Annual progression is subject to satisfactory performance. The successful applicant(s) will be engaged on a twelve months probationary period.
