VACANCIES FOR THE POSITION OF SENIOR FINANCE CENTRE EXECUTIVES AT THE FINANCE CENTRE DEPARTMENT

Applications are invited for the posts of Senior Finance Centre Executives at the Finance Centre Department - under Government contract - from persons who by virtue of their citizenship are entitled to take up employment and who are, or will on appointment, be resident in Gibraltar.

1. Reporting to the Finance Centre Director, the successful applicants will undertake activity and demonstrate behaviours showing advocacy for Gibraltar as the Finance Centre of choice to prospective corporate and individual investors.
2. These are specialist roles that require applicants to have extensive financial services experience internationally. They should, in addition, have knowledge of the insurance, private client and asset management / funds sectors and be able to effectively communicate at the highest level, either on an individual or group basis, with the target audience which will include Senior Executives and business owners across a broad spectrum. The intention is that successful applicants will dedicate themselves to the development of a specific industry sector whilst being able to assist and support the other key sectors as and when necessary. Job holders will be required to travel overseas.
3. The job holder is also required to support the Finance Centre Director as required in the fulfilment of the wider responsibilities of the Department.
4. An industry specific professional qualification, whilst not obligatory, may prove beneficial to an applicant.
5. A competitive salary will be offered commensurate with skills and experience.
