Licensed Guide Pass Renewal

Licensed Guide Passes, issued under the provisions of the Transport Act 1998 and the Transport Regulations 2000, effective from the 1st November 2012 are available for collection from the Information Office of the Gibraltar Tourist Board at Casemates Square as from Thursday 1 November 2012, Monday to Friday 0900-1730 hours.

Existing licensed guides may renew their passes automatically provided they bring their current pass, Gibraltar resident ID card together with two recent passport photographs, with effect from 1st November 2012 and by no later than 31 December 2012. Existing licensed guides who are not resident will need to bring their current pass, two recent passport photographs and a letter from the local tour operator who will be employing or sponsoring their services as a guide for tours within Gibraltar. After 31 December 2012, existing passes will lapse and the applicant will need to carry out a re-assessment before being issued with a new pass.

Further particulars regarding the Licensed Guide Scheme can be obtained from the Gibraltar Tourist Board, Casemates Square.

The public is advised that it is an offence in law for anyone to conduct guided tours for remuneration in Gibraltar, without a Licensed Guide accreditation.
