**Conditions of entry:**

1. This competition is open to all.
2. Participants can enter up to 6 photographs on the theme: **“CELEBRATING 60 YEARS OF QUEEN ELIZABETH'S REIGN - A GIBRALTAR PERSPECTIVE”**
3. Photographs should depict some link between Gibraltar and the Monarchy, especially The Queen, spanning the 60 years of her reign.
4. Entries must be prints and can be in black and white and/or colour. The photographs have to be mounted on proper mounting card. The size of the card must be 30 cm x 40 cm. The photograph may be any size within the card. The card must be either black or white. No other colour will be accepted.
5. The participant must have originated and must own the copyright of all work submitted. This applies equally to all components of composite images, whether assembled by traditional or digital means. The use of “copyright free” or “clip art” material is not acceptable.
6. All entries must be accompanied by the entry form at the back of these rules. The entry form must be completed in full and signed by the photographer (and parent/guardian in the case of those aged under 18) to indicate acceptance of the rules and conditions of entry.
7. Entry forms can be collected from the Ministry of Culture, The John Mackintosh Hall reception, The Gibraltar Photographic Society, and from photographic outlets and processing labs in town.
8. Entries must not bear any identifying marks, either on the front or back, otherwise they will be disqualified. Photographs will be identified by a number allocated to them when handed in.
9. Entries must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, together with the entry form.

The envelope must be marked :

QUEEN'S DIAMOND JUBILEE PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION and must also carry the name and address of the author, together with a contact telephone number and e-mail address.

10. Photographs must be handed in on or before the 22nd June 2012 at the John Mackintosh Hall reception. Entries will also be accepted at the premises of the Gibraltar Photographic Society at Wellington Front on 25th June 2012, between 7.00 p.m. and 9.00 p.m.
11. The prizes are:

1st prize:	£300 plus a trophy
2nd prize:	£200 plus a trophy
3rd prize:	£100 plus a trophy
4th prize:	£60 plus a trophy
5th prize:	£40 plus a trophy
12. Winners will be announced and prizes presented by the Minister for Culture, Heritage, Sport & Leisure, during the official opening of the exhibition which will be held at the Gustavo Bacarisas Gallery on Monday 9th July at 7.00 p.m. All participants and their guests are welcome to attend the opening.
13. All entries will be treated with every care but the organisers cannot be held responsible for loss or damage. Once the exhibition is over, entries may be collected from the Society's premises on any subsequent Monday evening, from 8.00pm to 9.00pm. Entries not collected by Friday 31st August will be considered unwanted, and disposed of at the discretion of the organisers.
14. The Director of Culture's decision on any issue outside the adjudication proper will be final.
