GIBRALTAR COURTS SERVICE

The Supreme Court Act makes provision for the appointment of Lay Assessors to sit in place of a jury on trials involving certain financial offences. Applications are sought for inclusion on the list of Lay Assessors.

Lay Assessors are volunteers who meet all the criteria to sit as jurors but have particular qualifications or experience to sit on complex financial trials. Where they are required, Lay Assessors will sit with the Judge and will together decide issues of fact and arrive at a verdict on the defendant.
