On Tuesday 17 April, the Department of Education and Training, in collaboration with the Bonita Trust, launched a charity initiative called "We Care" aimed at Middle School children. The event, which took place at Bishop Fitzgerald Middle School, was attended by the Minister for Education, the Hon Dr Bernard Linares, the CEO of the Bonita Trust, Mr Moe Cohen, and representatives from the Department of Education and Training, including the Director of Education and Training, Education Advisers and Head Teachers from the Middle Schools in Gibraltar, as well as a representation of teachers and pupils who will be involved in the initiative.

The project is aimed at creating an awareness in young children of the importance of giving and helping others. The Bonita Trust will be donating money to different charities while at the same time encouraging youngsters to perform good deeds in the immediate community. A merit points, system accordingly, devised will ensure that the children's designated charities benefit.
