The Chief Minister Peter Caruana leaves for London this evening. He will be addressing the Gibraltar Group in Parliament at the House of Commons tomorrow afternoon. The Chief Minister will be updating MPs on developments in Gibraltar affairs since he last addressed the Gibraltar lobby in Parliament in July 2006. The Chief Minister will cover areas such as progress in the new Constitution, Trilateral Forum, the EU Tax case, the economy and other matters.

Mr Caruana said, "It is important to keep up the lobby in Parliament, and to keep them informed and interested. They are personally committed to Gibraltar, but there are many demands on an MP's time and interests. The Parliamentary Group remains important to Gibraltar and we must continue to nurture it."

Mr Caruana, who is accompanied by private secretary John Reyes, returns to Gibraltar on Wednesday.
