Expansion of Recycling Programme – Household Batteries

The Ministry for the Environment is pleased to announce a further expansion of the recycling programme.

Apart from the existing battery recycling containers already available at Sacred Heart School, South District Post Office, Post Office at Main Street, Environmental Agency at 37 Town Range, Bayside and Westside Comprehensive Schools there are seventeen new red containers for the depositing of household batteries for recycling. These have been attached to the existing green glass recycling bins at the locations listed below.

Only household batteries should be deposited in red recycling containers. Household batteries are Dry Cell batteries such as AA, AAA, C, D, nickel-cadmium, small lead, lithium and button cell.

The Ministry takes this opportunity to remind the public that the green colour-coded bins are for glass bottles, drinking glasses, tumblers and jars only. Metal lids and metal bottle tops should be deposited separately in the yellow colour-coded bins. Aluminium and steel drink cans, steel food tins, household aerosols and clean aluminium foil as well as the metal bottle tops and metal lids from the glass bottles and jars are to be deposited in the yellow colour-coded bins. No other types of refuse should be deposited in these recycling bins. Ordinary litter bins are available nearby to dispose of any unwanted bags used for carrying these items.

The co-operation of the public will be appreciated to ensure its success.
