The Chief Minister & Mrs Caruana leave Gibraltar this weekend for an extended series of events related to the Gibraltar Day in London.

On Sunday the Chief Minister and Mrs Caruana will be attending a mass of thanksgiving at St Mary Church, Clapham which will be celebrated by the Bishop of Gibraltar Ralph Heskett. The mass will also involve members of the Royal Gibraltar Regiment who will parade the respective flags for the occasion. Gibraltarian Tenor Philip Borge will be singing at the Church Service also.

On Monday the Chief Minister will attend a finance centre reception and lunch at the Drapers Hall in which more than 300 senior finance professionals from both the UK and Gibraltar will attend. The Chief Minister will give a speech during the lunch.

On Monday the Chief Minister & Mrs Caruana will host the now traditional Gibraltar Day in London reception in the Guildhall with more than 1000 guests. The music for the evening will be provided by The Band and Drums of The Royal Gibraltar Regiment, The Band of the Corps of Royal Engineers and The Pipes and Drums of the London Scottish Regiment. The Chief Minister will take the final salute at a Sunset Ceremony to conclude the reception.
