Maesteg Ladies Choir

The Maesteg Ladies Choir, in Wales, recently visited Gibraltar and gave a recital, in honour of the Mayor.

The Mayor took the opportunity to request they convey to the Mayor of Maestag a couple of Mayoral gifts from Gibraltar, namely the publication depicting many of the prints and other works of art exhibited at the Tercentenary Exhibition in 2004, together with a brass plaque, bearing the Arms of Gibraltar, above an outline of the Rock of Gibraltar and the name of Gibraltar.

The Ladies of the Choir recently presented those gifts to the Mayor of Maestag and sent the Mayor a photograph of the presentation, together with an email of gratitude, in which they informed the Mayor that upon hearing the Mayor of Gibraltar was addressed as "His Worship", the Mayor of Maestag had requested his mode of designation be amended, so as to include that address, as well.

The Mayor of Maesteg has also written to the Mayor, thanking him for the gifts and for his attendance upon the town's Choir, saying he was "especially enthralled" by the Mayor's letter of gratitude to the Choir, and adding the gifts would be given "pride of place" within Maesteg's Council Chambers. The Mayor of Maesteg has frequently visited Gibraltar and hopes to formally call upon the Mayor, in order to discuss other opportunities.
