Europort Avenue – Excavation Works to lay New Duct System

A Contractor is to carry out excavation works across the main road of Europort Avenue in order to lay new infrastructure ducts from 2.00pm on Saturday 27th August 2011 to Monday 29 August 2011. During this time traffic travelling along North Mole Road, on reaching the Evacuation Roundabout, will be able to travel southbound along Europort Avenue. Europort Avenue will have one traffic lane closed from the northern junction of Harbour Views Road to the Evacuation Roundabout, during the time works are in progress. The rest of Europort Avenue will remain with its two traffic lanes. Thus access to the areas of Harbour Views, Morrison's Super store, Sir William Jackson Grove and the areas of Europort including St Bernard's Hospital, will remain via North Mole Road and or via Queensway. Road works and information signs will be placed strategically at main traffic junction route locations.
