All went through a very rigorous recruitment and selection procedure which needed to fulfil the requirements of Kingston University and St George's University, London and the requirements of the School of Health Studies and the GHA.

The course commenced on the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2008 and is one of the few Academic courses run by UK Universities that can be completed in its entirety in Gibraltar.
