### **Flat Bastion Road – Resurfacing Part of Main Road Phase 1**

In order to allow a Contractor to undertake resurfacing works along a section of Flat Bastion Road, the following traffic arrangements will be put in place. Flat Bastion Road from its junction with Prince Edward's Road and Castle Road, will be closed off as from 8.00am on Saturday 28 April 2012, for a period of 3 days not exceeding 10 hours every day. Works will continue during Sunday 29 April 2012 and Monday 30 April 2012, throughout the same hours. Traffic wanting to access the northern side of Flat Bastion Road will be able to do so up to the junction with Baca's Passage, where they will need to turn around to exit the area. Access will be controlled by the use of temporary traffic lights as from 10.00am onwards, with the road being reopened to allow access for residents after 6.00pm every day. Drivers are requested to drive with extra care as the road might be temporarily uneven whilst resurfacing works are being completed. During the time resurfacing works are in progress vehicular access to the south of Flat Bastion Road and Gardiners Road will be available via Europa Road. Parking restrictions will also be implemented as required. Temporary road works and diversion signs will be in place to advise drivers of the works ahead.

The Government would like to take this opportunity to apologise to the general public for any inconvenience that these works may cause to them.
