Government commences replacement programme of Chilton Court windows

The Government has commenced its programme of replacement of windows in Chilton Court. This is in line with the commitment made during the General Election campaign.

Chilton Court is occupied by members of the Royal Gibraltar Regiment and their families.

During the General Election, the GSLP/Liberals pledged to replace the windows following representations made by residents.

The Government authorised the commencement of works earlier this year and the windows replacement programme started last week.

The programme has been estimated to cost £300,000 and is estimated to be completed after the summer.
