Forensic Factory is an educational programme which has been running since 2006. It is an innovative, artistic programme designed and delivered by the youth work staff at the Youth Centre.

The programme content aims to encourage participation from young people between the ages of 13-17 who have an interest in the creative arts. It explores opportunities with young people involved to build a positive image and self-esteem.
