### **Flat Bastion Road – Refurbishment Works to a Property**

In order to allow a contractor to undertake refurbishment works to the façade of a building near the junction of Baca's Passage section of Flat Bastion Road, the following traffic arrangements will be put in place:

Flat Bastion Road from its northern junction with Prince Edward's Road to Baca's Passage will be closed off to traffic from 9.00am to no later than 6.00pm on both Saturday 7 July 2012 and Sunday 8 July 2012 and during the same hours the following weekend, Saturday 14 July and Sunday 15 July 2012.

Access to the southern side of Flat Bastion Road, which will be converted into a two-way traffic flow system, will remain via Europa Road and Gardiner's Road. A stop and go hand signal operation will be implemented during the time that works are in progress as through traffic will be maintained at all times. Parking restrictions will also be implemented as required along this stretch of road whilst works are in progress. Temporary road works and diversion signs will be in place to inform drivers of the works ahead.

The Government would like to take this opportunity to apologise to the general public for any inconvenience that these works may cause.
